

## COTTON WEEKLY RESEARCH REPORT 19<sup>th</sup> Sep 2022

#### **Domestic market summary**

#### **Domestic Market Scenario:**

During the past week cotton fiber shanker-6 prices remained weak in the market. Domestic cotton arrivals have started in the markets of Northern and Central India while arrivals have just started in Southern part of the country mainly Telangana (Warangal). This year arrivals in Telangana have begun almost a month early from normal.

With the increase in arrivals, the raw cotton and fiber prices have declined from Rs. 98,000 to Rs. 85,000 a candy during the week under review. However, Indian cotton prices are still higher by around 15% to 20% compared to international prices. Cotton prices in Warangal are trading at Rs. 8,199 per quintal. At present, the overall quality of cotton is good in the market.

#### **Major Market Highlights:**

- North India Cotton arrival are picking up in the market. Market is volatile and leading of bearish trend in India.
- Indian MCX is also sharply during the week under review.
- All India cotton sowing reached 126 lakh hectares. Despite some rain during this week crop conditions looks quite good. Also, India is heading towards higher yield this year.
- Due to sharp decline in NY Indian basis again got high. Mills are not able to find buyer of yarn so running slowly to minimize the loss.

#### Market Highlights:

The cotton requirement by the domestic textile industry is likely to be more than the production in the 2022-23 season and duty-free export of cotton that may result in 12% to 15% of good quality raw cotton going out of the country, which may lead to cotton shortage during the off-season.

AgriWatch expects that the coming 2-3 weeks are very crucial for the cotton crop. The ongoing heavy rains in Maharashtra and Gujarat may affect the cotton arrivals in the coming weeks. Also, if rain continues the cotton yield and quality may get affected adversely, currently the crop is in flowering stage in most of the key producing regions.

According to AgriWatch cotton fiber prices are likely to range between Rs. 84,500 – Rs. 90,200 per candy in the coming week amid lower demand from the domestic as well as international market. Whereas, raw cotton prices may see an uptrend in the coming weeks if rains continue as predicted by Indian Metrological Department (IMD), further the cotton arrivals may get delayed in coming weeks.

As of Sept. 16<sup>th</sup>, 2022 Cotton sowing has reached 127.14 Lakh Ha. Vs 118.23 Lakh Ha. same period last year. Agriwatch expects overall the cotton sowing to reach 128 Lakh Ha. in 2022-23 season. Earlier, due to excess rainfall in July month cotton sowing was affected in central and southern India.




#### Kapas (Raw Cotton) Weekly Price Scenario


Cotton shanker-6 at Gondal market traded higher at Rs. 10,655 per quintal against the minimum support price of Rs. 6025 per quintal.







According to the U.S. Crop progress report, as of 18<sup>th</sup> Sep 2022, U.S cotton Cotton Bolls opening stands at 59 percent which is higher than that of the previous season (46 percent). In the previous week cotton bolls opening was 49 percent. Overall 4 percent of the U.S Cotton Crop is in excellent condition, 30 percent in good to a fair condition which was 28 percent in the previous week.

According to USDA, Cotton and product update report, global cotton production is estimated higher at 118.40 million bales, and stocks are projected higher this month. However, Consumption has slightly decreased to 118.60 million bales with lower projected use in Pakistan and Vietnam. Global trade is unchanged as higher U.S. exports more than offset lower Brazil shipments.

Pakistan cotton production is forecasted down by 700,000 bales to 5.5 million bales amid smaller crop estimation due to heavy rains and floods. Cotton consumption is estimated lower by 400,000 bales to 10.5 million bales. Overall cotton imports are likely to increase in the 2022-23 season to 4.8 million bales. However, with a significant decline in production from the United States, The All-Pakistan Textile Mills Association is reported to have asked government officials to consider lifting the country's restriction on imports of Indian cotton. Earlier, Pakistan has restricted India cotton in 2019 due to border disputes.





- Technically market is under long liquidation as the market has witnessed a drop in open interest, now Cotton has broken support at 35550, resistance is now likely to be seen at 34890, a move above could see prices testing 35090
- MACD indicates bearish momentum while oscillator RSI pointing down in the neutral zone. Both
  indicators point for a range-bound market with a slightly weak bias.
- Overall, the prices are expected to remain range-bound to slightly weak in the coming days.
