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Summary

Agriwatch expects that maize would trade in a range bound zone with a firm bias for coming term. Also, maize crop has been destroyed in various parts of U.P and M.P due to un-favourable weather conditions and rabi maize stock in Bihar is almost finished, this will provide support to maize market in coming weeks, with new arrivals to start soon from October.

Sources revealed that good quality maize is being traded in Bihar between Rs. 1,800 to Rs. 1,850 per quintal. Whereas, maize is being supplied to Bangladesh between Rs. 1,850-Rs.1900 per quintal for poultry purpose sourced from West Bengal.

The cottonseed oil prices have decreased around 2-3 percent from the previous week. The cottonseed oil prices were at Rs. 1431 and Rs. 1444 per 10 kgs in Hyderabad and Mumbai market respectively. The cottonseed oilcake prices have slightly decreased from the previous week. The average price of cottonseed oilcake in the Kadi market was Rs. 2642 per quintal from Rs. 2764 per quintal and in Akola was at Rs. 2840 per quintal from Rs. 2926 per quintal the previous week.

During the week of Sep 16 to Sep 23, 2021, the weekly average price in India rose by 3.05 percent to Rs. 2024.52 per quintal against Rs. 1964.54 per quintal in the previous week. Wheat average prices also increased by 10.69 percent from Rs. 1828.92 per quintal in last year during the same period of time. The availability of stocks added with higher export demand helps increase in the wheat prices. As per agriculture ministry's fourth advance estimate, Wheat output is expected to reach a new high of 109.52 million tonnes in 2020-21. It is 1.53% higher than 107.86 from last year record amid good monsoon rain last year. Wheat procurement for the Rabi marketing season 2021-22 is completed in India. Wheat was procured in excess of 433.32 LMT, a record high compared to 389.93 LMT in previous seasons. The current RMS procurement operations have already benefited over 49.20 lakh farmers with MSP value of Rs.85,603.57 crore.


Compared to previous months the availability of stocks for wheat is decreasing along with increase in demand for Indian wheat in international market which makes the wheat cash market to trade steady to slightly firm in the coming week.


Soymeal prices are likely to feature range bound with weak bias movement amid weak export demand at higher price. Dull demand at higher prices from poultry sector will remain negative for the market. The soy meal prices (Indore) are likely to feature range-bound movement between Rs. 75,000 – 90,000 /MT.


Rapeseed-mustard is expected to feature firm tone in near term due to low domestic supply and bullish global cues. The seed prices are likely to witness the price levels between 8,000 –9,000/Qtl. in short-run.




Trend - Raw Material, Feed

Soy meal

The domestic weekly average soymeal price went down as compared to previous week on weakness in soybean price. Additionally, GOI decision to allow to import GM soymeal via five ports till 31st oct'21 too dragged soymeal price. Arrival of new crop may put more pressure in near term.

In addition to existing two ports Nhava sheva and LCS petrapole, GOI has allowed to import GM soymeal via three additional port - Mumbai sea port, Tuticorin sea port and Visakhapatnam sea port.GOI has extended the GM soymeal import date to 31st January,2022. Earlier it was 31st Oct21.

India's soymeal export likely to remain weak, as india is now totally outpriced in world market Indian soymeal is trading at around \$1200/MT Vs Argentina soymealat \$400/MT. Export is expected to remain below 17 lakh metric tons. The high price of soybean meal has hit not only the export of soymeal but also the poultry farmers mainly small farmers and finding very difficult to survive in this difficult time. According to USDA, US Aug'21 monthly average soymeal export price eased by \$3 to \$422/ton as compared to last month. Brazil Aug'21 monthly average soymeal export price eased by \$8 at \$418/ton as compared to previous month. Argentina Aug'21 monthly average soymeal export price too eased by \$3 at \$393/ton as compared to previous month. India's August soymeal export price surged to over \$1100/ton due to short supply.

According to USDA September report, world 2021/22 soymeal production is estimated higher at 258.45 million tonnes vs 249.75 million tonnes against last year record. According to Solvent extractor association of india, India's Aug'2021 soymeal exports declined by 81% to 10,975 metric tonnes compared to 58,190 metric tonnes in the same period last year. Further, the soymeal shipments too declined by 38% to 155,757 metric tonnes in aggregate, during the months (April-Aug.) of financial year 2020-21 compared to 249,339 metric tonnes during the corresponding period last year.

Additionally, Export of oilmeals for the month of Aug'2021 provisionally reported at 164,831 tons compared to 171,515 tons in Aug 2020 i.e. down by 4%. The overall export of oilmeals during April – Aug 2021 is reported at 1,091,664 tons compared to 1,013,178 tons i.e. up by 8%.

The soymeal export price spread of India vs Argentina (FAS Kandla and FOB Argentina) have further declined to US \$ 210/MT in May'21 vs US \$ 215/MT in April'21, leading incompetitiveness for Indian soymeal exports.



The domestic weekly average soymeal prices at Indore was 0.9% down to Rs 84,833 /MT and was quoted between Rs 84,000 – 86,000/MT compared to the weekly average of Rs 85,583 /MT and was traded between the price ranges of Rs 84,000 – 88,000/MT previous week. Weekly average prices at various centers also closed lower side compared to last week prices. At Latur, the weekly average soymeal prices declined by 2.4% to Rs. 84,000 /MT compared to Rs. 86,000 /MT a week ago however in Nanded it was quoted 4.2% down at Rs. 88,333/MT compared to Rs. 92,000/MT a week ago. In Kota the meal prices up by 0.4% to Rs. 90,833/MT compared to Rs. 90,500/MT previous week.

Rapeseed - Mustard Seed

This week Rapeseed-mustard seed prices likely to remain elevated on tight supply in the country and bullish global cues.

There is significant demand for RM seed oil especially from the states of North India like Bihar, Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal and likely to rise significantly during the winter season, during the festival and pickle making season.

Mustard prices likely to under pinned by, firm demand, declining stock and arrival, strength in oilseed complex, and strength in CME canola futures due to lower production.

It is estimated that approximately 75-80% of the current mustard crop has been crushed, while 20-25% of the crushing is yet to be done. Rapeseed Mustard increased by 0.5% to Rs.8,779/Qtl this week as compared to Rs 8,738/Qtl last week and arrival declined. In Sri Ganganagar, the weekly average prices of rapeseed oilcake was 0.12% down to Rs 3,262/Qtl from previous week at Rs. 3,266/qtl.


This week all india mustard arrival witnessed mild gains to 11.20 lakh as compared to previous week at 11 lakh bags.AW has revised India's 2021/22 rapeseed-mustard production up to 8.54 million tonnes from 8.0 million tonnes estimated in its previous forecast and it is up 18% from 7.21 million tonnes estimated last season. The Government estimation of mustard crop is high at 10.4 MT. The COOIT has estimated mustard production at 8.90 MT.


India's exports for rapeseed meal during April-Aug'2021 was up 11% at 542,630 metric tonnes compared to 487,060 metric tonnes during the same period previous marketing season. The export of rapeseed meal in Aug'21 is reported at 63,058 metric tonnes against last year 50,580 metric tonnes during the same period i.e. up by 25%, However 14% down as compared to Aug20.Improved rapeseed-oilcake shipments to the traditional destinations will continue to lend support to the oilcake prices at higher levels. South Korea, Vietnam, Thailand, Bangladesh and few other south-east Asian countries were the major buyers of mustard meal of Indian origin.


According to Solvent Extractor Association of India, Rapeseed oil import scenario- India imported 0.00 lakh tons rapeseed (Canola) oil in July 2021 same as in June 2020.

Canada canola production is down by 31% as compared to five-year average, yield down by 32%. However, area stood 1% up as compared to five-year average. Canola importers may switch to other countries such as Ukraine, Australia, for substitutes amid lower production. There will be very little canola left for export in Canada.

Sources revealed that maize in Nizamabad market is being traded at Rs. 1,900 per quintal. Maize is being supplied to Tamil Nadu between Rs. 2,150-Rs.2,200 per quintal for feed purpose sourced from Davangere.

Corn on CBOT rose by 3.84 USD/MT to 207.57 USD/MT for December '21 contract as compared to previous week. There is expectation that Corn on CBOT will remain bullish for coming near term, it is trying to reach the resistance of 570 US\$ per bushel.

U.S. Maize exports have reached to 3.59 MMT for the 2021-22 marketing year, with the exports of 1.92 MMT for the period of (3 Sep-9 Sep) 2021, for the destinations like Mexico (177,500 MT), El Salvador (7,200 MT), Canada (6,100 MT), Taiwan (1,000 MT), and South Korea (200 MT).

Wheat prices were almost steady at various trading centers in this week between September14th to 20th September, 2021, with Indore market showing firm prices due to lower supplies compared to previous weeks. Wheat is projected to trade steady to slightly firm tone in expectation of low supplies in mandies and higher export pace.

Outlook: Feed prices are expected to feature in a range bound zone in coming week.
