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Summary

Agriwatch expects that maize would trade range bound with firm bias for coming near term. It is expected that on the account of current Rabi maize sowing scenario; delay in sowing of rabi maize at various major producing states with decreased arrivals and also increase in demand scenario during coming months with winter season to be at its peak, prices of maize are expected to attain a firm bias in coming long term. Sources revealed that good quality Maize is being traded in Bihar between Rs. 1,900 to Rs. 2,100 per quintal. Good quality Maize is being supplied to Bangladesh at Rs. 2,100 per quintal sourced from West Bengal. Also, poultry demand seems to be revived in Kolkata and Banaras. Poultry feed Maize is being supplied to Kolkata at Rs. 2,100 per quintal sourced from Dalkhola.

During the week of December 01 to 08, 2021, the weekly average price in India was slightly up by 0.10 percent at Rs. 2135.38 per quintal against Rs. 2133.31 per quintal the previous week. Also, wheat average prices increased by 16.69 percent from Rs. 1829.92 per quintal same time last year. On 06th December the price of wheat in Kanpur market for mill delivery was Rs. 2025 per quintal which is 0.25% higher than Rs. 2020 per quintal the previous month. The price remains almost steady in all the major market compare to previous week as the demand along with extension of free ration under PMGKAY has stabilized the market. In coming week also, we can expect market to stay in range bound with mix bias as the offseason scenario continues. As of 03rd December, wheat sowing was done in 200.66 lakh hectares up by 7.24 lakh hectares from 193.42 lakh hectares the previous year during corresponding period. In Madhya Pradesh, sowing was done in around 52.81 lakh hectares up by 6.07 lakh hectares from 46.74 lakh hectares the previous year.

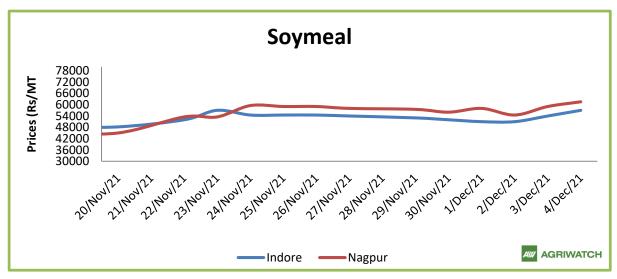
In state of Uttar Pradesh, around 14.72 crore NFSA beneficiaries are covered under the PMGKAY. So far under the scheme, the department had allocated a total amount of 139.14 lakh metric tonne of wheat and rice to the state incurring an estimated total subsidy of Rs. 43,335 crores. As per Agriwatch sources, 1.86 lakh tonnes of wheat were exported from India during the month of October 2021 at an average FOB of \$322.21 per tonne. It is 0.45 percent higher compared to September with export of 1.85 lakh tonnes. Bangladesh continues to be the largest importer of Indian wheat with 1.43 lakh tonnes 1.42 percent higher compared to previous month export of 1.41 lakh tonnes. Nepal is the second largest importer with 0.09 lakh tonnes of imports and Srilanka being the third largest importer with 0.04 lakh tonnes.

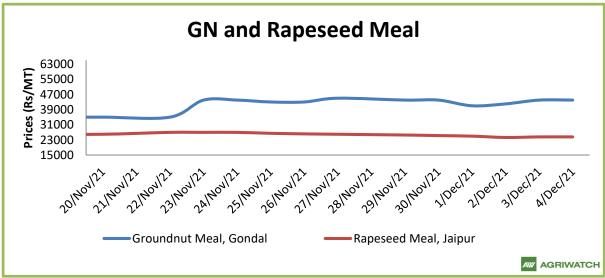
Soymeal prices are likely to trade with firm bias followed by strength in soybean prices. The soy meal prices (Indore) are likely to feature range-bound movement between Rs. 53,000 – 60,000 /MT.

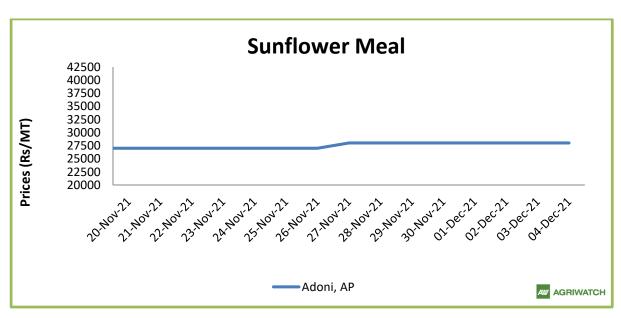
Rapeseed-mustard is expected to feature firm tone in near term amid low availability in mandis, firm demand and bullish global cues. The seed prices are likely to witness the price levels between 8,000 –8,600/Qtl. in short-run.



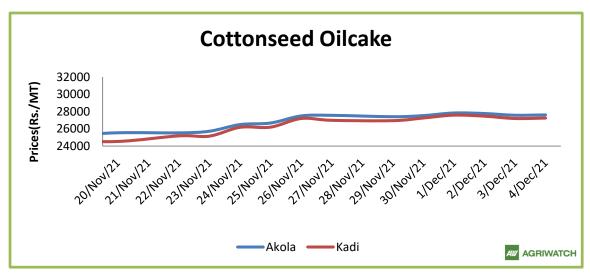
Trend - Raw Material, Feed

Soy meal

This week Indore weekly average soymeal price went down by 2.6% as compared to previous week amid concern over extension of deadline for GM soymeal imports and weakness in soybean price.

The weekly average prices of soymeal at Indore declined 2.6% to Rs 53,000 /MT and was quoted between Rs 51,000 - 57,000/MT throughout the week. This compares with previous week's average of Rs 54,416/MT and range of Rs 52,000 - 57,000/MT. Soymeal prices remained weak amid concern over extension of deadline for GM soymeal imports and weakness in soybean price.

Weekly average prices at various centers also closed down compared to last week prices. At Latur, the weekly average soymeal prices decreased by 1.3% to Rs. 58,916/MT compared to Rs. 59,666 /MT a week ago, in Nanded it was quoted 2.5% down at Rs. 57,750/MT compared to Rs. 59,250 /MT a week ago. In Kota the meal prices went down by 2.1% to Rs. 56,766/MT compared to Rs. 58,000/MT previous week.

As per sources, farmers are willing to hold more soybean anticipating higher prices in the future. As a result, sale to soy processors remained low. October crush total was 37% below last year's, according to SOPA and is expected to remain below normal in November.

According to USDA November'21 report, world 2021/22 soymeal production is estimated higher at 258.51 million tonnes vs 248.13 million tonnes against last year record. India's 2021-22 soymeal production pegged at 5.06 MMT vs 4.90 MMT in 2020-21.

According to Solvent extractor association of india, India's October'2021 soymeal exports declined by 88% to 14,538 metric tonnes compared to 120,290 metric tonnes in the same period last year. Further, the soymeal shipments too declined by 60% to 176,126 metric tonnes in aggregate, during the months (April-Oct.) of financial year 2020-21 compared to 438,205 metric tonnes during the corresponding period last year.

Additionally, Export of oilmeals for the month of October'2021 provisionally reported at 157,467 tons compared to 318,706 tons in 2020 i.e. down by 51%. The overall export of oilmeals during April – October 2021 is reported at 14,33231 tons compared to 161,9222 tons i.e. down by 11%.

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Rapeseed - Mustard Seed

This week RM seed prices remained elevated and went slightly down by 3.9% on stock limit by Rajasthan government. However, supply still remains short on demand and global dynamics still remains bullish and underpinning the price in near term.

Rapeseed Mustard weekly average price remained elevated and went down by 3.9% to Rs.8,200/Qtl this week as compared to Rs 8,529/Qtl last week, In Sri Ganganagar, the weekly average prices of rapeseed oilcake too went down by 3.60% to Rs 3,241/Qtl from previous week at Rs. 3,362/qtl.

This week in Rajasthan, mustard arrival stood at 73,333 lakh bags as compared to previous week at 62,500 lakh bags.

AW has revised India's 2021/22 rapeseed-mustard production up to 8.54 million tonnes from 8.0 million tonnes estimated in its previous forecast and it is up 18% from 7.21 million tonnes estimated last season.

The Government estimation of mustard crop is high at 10.4 MT. The COOIT has estimated mustard production at 8.90 MT.

According to GOI, as on 26th Nov, All India Mustard sowing is up by 29.4% at 66.42 Lakh Ha compared with 51.33 Lakh Ha last year.

According to Department of agriculture, Rajasthan, as on 03nd Dec, Rapeseed Mustard sowing is up by 41% and stood at 33.38 lakh hectare vs 23.72 lakh hectare last year same period.

Rajasthan govt. has imposed stock limit on oil seeds and edible oils on 26th Nov'21 till 31st march 22. Stock limit for Mustard seed, Toria, Taramira and Rayda for whole sellers is 2000 Qtl and retail trader oilseed storage limit pegged at 100 Qtl.

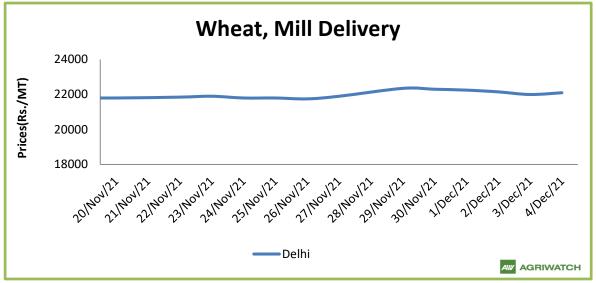
Mustard sowing expected to end with 18-20% increase in acreage, farmers are opting mustard over other crops amid lucrative prices.

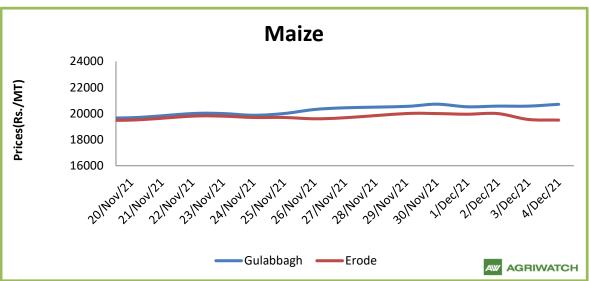
According to Solvent extractors association of India, the export of rapeseed meal in September'21 is reported at 62,725 metric tonnes against last year 140,830 metric tonnes during the same period i.e. down by 55%.

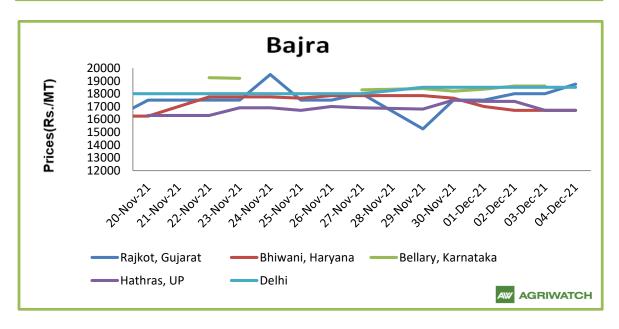
USDA in its latest report cut canola export by 9.5% to 5.7 MMT as compared to 10.58 MMT previous year, ending stocks reduced by 14.3%.

In the November'21 USDA report, Canada rapeseed production remain unchanged at 13 million tonnes compared to previous month Vs 19.48 MMT last year. Mustard prices likely to underpinned by, firm demand, declining stock and arrival, and strength in CME canola futures due to lower production due to prolonged heatwave in Canada which resulted in lower production.

Sources revealed that Maize in Nizamabad market is being traded between Rs. 1,800 - Rs. 1,850 per quintal. Loose Maize in market of Davangere, Karnataka is being traded at Rs. 1,750 per quintal. Maize for poultry feed purpose is being supplied to Hyderabad at Rs. 1,950 per quintal sourced from Nizamabad.

Corn on CBOT fell by 3.35 USD/MT to 225.19USD/MT for December '21 contract as compared to previous week. However, Agriwatch expects that Corn on CBOT would be supported by corn demand for the purpose of ethanol production and poultry as well. U.S. Maize exports have reached to 96.46 MMT for the 2021-22 marketing year, with the exports of 9.38 MMT for the period of (19th Nov – 25th Nov) 2021, exports were up by 1 percent from the previous week and up 5 percent from the prior 4-week average, to the destinations like Mexico (382,400 MT), China (138,000 MT), Japan (118,500 MT), Colombia (110,800 MT), and Canada (49,000 MT).

Wheat prices were trading almost steady in these four markets since last four weeks. The market is expected to stay in the range bound with mixed bias in coming week.

Outlook: Feed prices are expected to feature in a range bound zone with firm bias in coming week.
