

Guar Daily Fundamental Report 01st September, 2017

Domestic Fundamentals:

- Mostly weak sentiments reported in major spot market on Thursday amid lower arrivals.
- Guar prices witnessed a major fall due to rain in producing regions. Guar October contract
 touched a low of 3956 from an opening price of 4116. Recent rain has added to selling
 pressure that was already active above 4000. If rains continue in upcoming days prices can
 slide down to 3820-3840. Traders are already seeing current year crop lower than last year by
 around 15% to 20% as of now.
- According to latest update, area sown in Gujarat until 28th August 2017 is 166300 hectares compared to 192800 hectares in the previous Kharif season. Area of guar is expected to be lower this season due to crop loss. Furthermore farmers are also shifting to other crops like cotton in irrigated areas and pulses in rain fed areas as these crops are fetching more returns. The last three year average normal area for guar seed in Gujarat is 292400 hectares.
- As per latest update by Rajasthan agriculture department, guar seed has been sown in 2744.9 thousand hectares until 17th August 2017 against a target of 3800 thousand hectares for current Kharif season. As compared to last year for the same date, area is up 6.4 thousand hectares. Last Kharif season guar was sown in 3530 thousand hectares. The last five year average area ending 2011-15 for guar seed in Rajasthan is 4424 thousand hectares.
- Guargum exports for April-June 2017 in terms of value is Rs 1176 Crore compared to Rs 547
 Crore in April-June 2016. Exports have increased by around 115% in terms of value
 compared to last year. With recovery of international oil market demand for guargum is also
 expected to increase in coming months.
- All India weekly average prices increased by 3.01 percent to Rs. 3487.88 per quintal during the week ended 23rd August 2017. Guar seed average price were ruling at Rs 3385.90 per quintal during 09-15 August 2017. As compared to prices in the week 16-23 August 2016, the prices are firm by 1.53 percent. Prices are expected to remain steady to firm in coming days.
- India has received 572.4 mm of actual rainfall against 598.2 mm of normal rainfall since the beginning of monsoon season until 16th August. Northwest and East & Northeast India are the only regions to receive more than normal rainfall. In the week (10th 16th August) India has received rainfall below LPA by 16% and the worst hit region was central India which received rainfall below LPA by 63%. Furthermore a low pressure is developing in the Bay of Bengal which is likely to bring in central India which has seen a weak monsoon in last week.
- Government has imposed 5 percent GST on guar meal making it less competitive compared
 to other cattle feeds available in the market. Furthermore a 5 percent GST on guar gum has
 also upset export demand for the commodity. Trading activities are sluggish as traders are
 still unclear regarding various aspects of GST.



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As per data released by baker hughes the number of oil rigs in USA has decreased to 940 until 25th August 2017 down by 6 compared to last week and up by 451 compared to 18th August 2016. Guar gum is used in hydraulic fracturing for extracting oil and gas; therefore, as the number of oilrigs increases or decreases the demand for guar gum is also affected.

Outlook: Prices are likely to move steady to weak in coming days.
