



Agriwatch Agri Commodity Index



The Agriwatch Agri Commodities Index dipped 0.32% to 114.85 during the week ended Feb 4, 2017 from 115.21 during the previous week. The base for the Index and all sub-Indices is 2014 (=100).



The Agriwatch Agri commodity other non-food articles Index increased by 4.86% to 98.94 during the week ended February 04, 2016.

Executive Summary

Domestic Guar Seed Market Summary

Guar prices are expected to remain lower compared to last year. The principal reason for this is higher carryover stocks. Stocking activities are high as traders are stocking major portion of arrivals. Guar seed arrivals in this week are higher compared to last week by around 16276 tonnes. Currently guar seed loose prices are hovering around Rs. 3000-3200 per guintal. Prices are expected to be range bound to weak in the upcoming week.

According to second advance estimate issued by Gujarat's department of agriculture for guar seed the area, production and yield are 352000 hectares, 242000 tonnes and 687 kg/hectare respectively compared to final advance estimate issued in December the area, production and yield has been increased by 43000 hectares, 85000 tonnes and 56 kg/hectare.

According to IBIS (provisional data) for the month of November, Export of guar seed products i.e. powder, Split and meal has decreased by 3666 metric tonnes compared to last month. India has exported 25872 tonnes of guar products in the month of November. Of the total quantity, 16053 tonnes is guar gum powder and the remaining is Guar split (3209 tonnes) and Guar meal (6610 tonnes).

According to IBIS (provisional data), export of guar seed products (Guar Powder, Split and Meal) have increased compared to last week. In the week (21-26 November), the exports were around 8625 metric tonnes compared to 7684 metric tonnes in the week (14-20 November). The export of all guar split and guar gum powder has increased.

According to IBIS (provisional data) for 21-26 November'16, the average \$FOB/Tonne has increased for guar split, guar meal and guar gum compared to last week. India has exported 5056 metric tonnes of guar gum powder at an average fob of \$1401.56/tonne, 1420 metric tonnes of guar split at an average fob of \$969.24/tonne and 2149 metric tonnes of guar meal at an average fob of \$497.99/tonne.

Total guar seed products export from India for the week (21-26 November) was 8625 tonnes. Out of the total around 4157.41 tonnes was exported from Mundra Port, 1352.61 tonnes from Jodhpur concor ICD and 1145.68 tonnes from Ahmedabad ICD. Whereas last week (14-20 November) 3133.26 tonnes was exported from Mundra Port, 1143.64 tonnes from Jodhpur concor ICD and 1181.7 tonnes from Ahmedabad ICD.

As far as Arrivals are concerned, Adampur (Haryana) market (biggest market of guar in North) reported higher arrivals (9000 quintals) compared to previous week 6500 quintals.

As far as arrivals are concerned Bikaner market, reported higher arrivals (5200 Quintals), arrivals compared to previous week 4974 quintals.

Recommendation:


Weekly Call - : Market participants are advised to Sell Guar seed at 3345 levels for a target of 3240 with a stop loss at 3381 on closing basis.



Guar Seed Fundamental Analysis and Outlook-:

Domestic Front

- In the week ended 03 February'17, Guar seed weekly average prices decreased by Rs 53 /- qtl during the week compared to previous week and settled at Rs 3420 per quintal.
- In addition, Guar gum weekly average prices were down by Rs. 31.67/- qtl and settled at Rs. 6358 per quintal. Weak demand for guar gum from domestic as well as overseas market led the prices down this week.
- According to first advance estimate for 2016-17 issued by Rajasthan's Department of Agriculture for Guar seed the area, production and yield are 2223474 hectares, 1962424 tonnes and 549 kg/hectare respectively. As compared to fourth advance estimate for 2015-16, the area, production and yield have decreased by1209842 hectares, 261050 tonnes and 84kg/hectare respectively.
- \geq According second advance to issued Gujarat's estimate by department of agriculture for guar seed the area, production and yield 352000 hectares, 242000 are 687 kg/hectare tonnes and to final respectively compared estimate advance issued in December the area, production and yield has been increased by 43000 hectares, 85000 tonnes and 56 kg/hectare.






Export Scenario

Export Scenario (21st - 26th November 2016)

During this week 8625 tonnes of guar was exported out of which 5056 tonnes was guar gum powder, 2149 tonnes was guar meal and 1420 tonnes guar gum splits. As compared to last week, the export of guar gum powder and guar split has increased whereas export of guar meal has slightly decreased.



Millers/Processors Margin


In the week ended 03 February '17, average crush margin is Rs. -69.82 /Quintal, compared to last week's -85.85 /Quintal. Therefore crushing is not favorable for Millers/Processors.


Higher degree of increase in guar gum prices compared to guar seed prices led the margin up this week.

Guar Seed to Gum Ratio:

Ratio of guar seed to guar gum for week ended 03 February'17 is 1.86, higher compared to last week's 1.84

Overall, buoyant demand of gum from overseas and good demand of seed from millers has increased the overall ratio.
