Executive Summary

Domestic Guar Seed Market Summary

- Area under guar is expected to fall in year 2023 in wake of significant rise in area under bajra and moong in Rajasthan amid the good rainfall in the region. The overall area too is likely to be down due to lower realization on guar over the last two years.
- During the week, the guar prices extended the previous week's gain amid the expectations of acreage shift to other more profitable crops reversing the trend where guar remained bearish for the last few months.
- The weekly Jodhpur delivery Guarseed price went up by 1.4% and the gum by 3%.
- The total arrivals during the week was up by 3% as compared to the previous week.
- As on 14th July '2023, the Baker Hughes rig count declined for the 11th week in a row amid the weaker crude oil prices and lower demand.

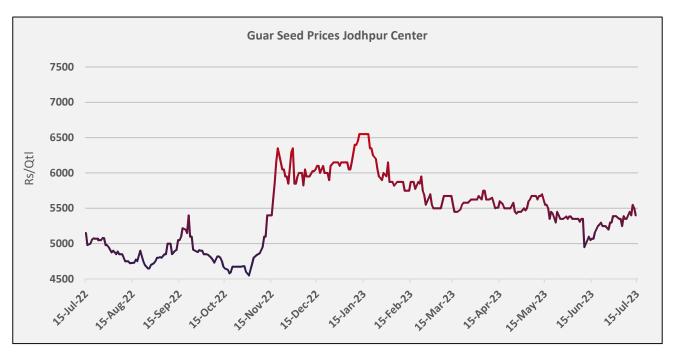
Outlook – Guar seed (Spot, Jodhpur basis):

• The Jodhpur Guar seed delivery prices are likely to stay in the range between INR 5,000–5,500/Qtl. in the short-run. Guar gum is expected to trade in the range of 10,500-11,500/qtl in near term amid the bullish market trend.

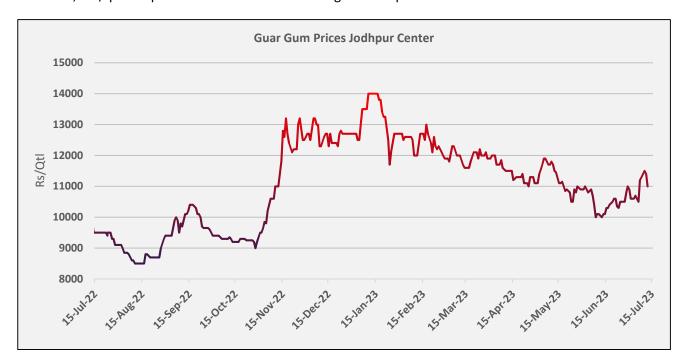


Domestic Market Fundamentals

During the reviewed week, the market exhibited a bullish trend, continuing the previous week's gains and prices went up for the 4th week in a row. The average weekly prices for Guar seed Jodhpur delivery experienced a 1.4% increase, reaching INR 5,429 per quintal compared to the previous week's INR 5,353 per quintal amid the expectations of acreage shift.



During the week under review, weekly average prices of guar gum went up by 3% at INR 11,071/qtl. as compared to INR 10,767/qtl. the previous week in tandem with guar seed prices.

- As per the latest data released by the government of Rajasthan, the guar sowing in the state is 18% ahead at 15.7 lakh Ha as compared to the previous year same period at 13.3 Lakh Ha. The gain in Guar acreage may be attributed to the good rainfall received in the parts of western Rajasthan, which has, as on 14th July received 118% of excessive rainfall.
- The key reason attributed to the increase in acreage so far in Rajasthan is the rains brought in by the cyclone in June that allowed for early planting in the western part of the state including districts of Sriganganagar, Hanumangarh etc.. This year farmers in Rajasthan are cultivating Guar along with Moong and other crops. Normally the sowing of the crop starts from 1st week of July onwards. Overall, the crop condition is reportedly good at this point of time amid good rainfall over the state. Even though the sowing was early in a few districts and the planting / sowing numbers seem high for this time of the year, in the key growing areas of Rajasthan like Bikaner, Jodhpur etc. the pace of planting is still slow and yet to pick up. But looking at the rainfall activity over the state and good realization to farmers in other crops it is likely that overall, the planted area this year in Rajasthan may remain lower
- In western Rajasthan, in the period between 1st June to 14th July '2023, cumulative rainfall is 118% of LPA. As the region is receiving good rainfall, the major crops like moong and cotton have been sown in the early June '23 and from this week guar as well as moth sowing has also started. The major acreage of guar is in Jaisalmer, Barmer and Bikaner districts, in which sowing has just started and most likely will be completed in the month of July '23.

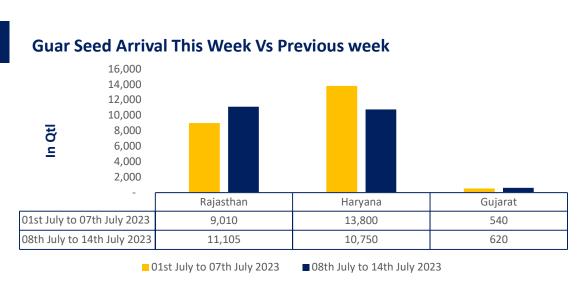

Guar sowing in Lunkransar, Nokha, and

Anupgarh districts of Rajasthan is nearly finished, and market sources indicate that the acreage dedicated to guar in these regions is lower by approximately 10-15% this season compared to the previous year. Farmers have opted to cultivate more profitable crops such as moong and cotton. Consequently, there is an expectation of a price increase for guar this season due to the anticipated lower production.

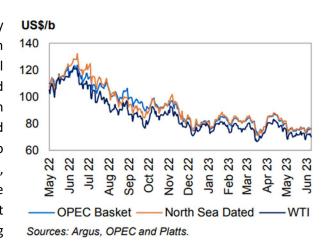


Guar seed arrivals: During the week under review, the overall guar seed arrivals went down by 3.7% at 22,475 qtl. as compared to the last week at 23,350 qtl. In Rajasthan, the arrivals went up by 23% amid the good prices and increased demand of guar in the market, while in Haryana it went down by 22% during this week amid the unfavourable weather conditions. As of now, 50-55% of the estimated production of the previous season has arrived in the market.



Crude Oil- Spot Price

Crude spot prices experienced a significant decline, completely wiping out the gains made in the previous month. The decline can be attributed to selloffs in futures markets, abundant crude oil supply in Northwest Europe, an uncertain demand outlook, and mixed refining margins. Furthermore, soft buying interest from multiple Asian buyers, caused by refinery turnarounds, added downward pressure on spot prices. Diesel margins also experienced weeks of continuous decline, particularly in Asia, further contributing to the weakening of oil prices. Despite the overall bearish sentiment, certain factors provided some support to spot prices. A significant reduction in US crude oil stocks during the week of May 16 provided some relief to the market.



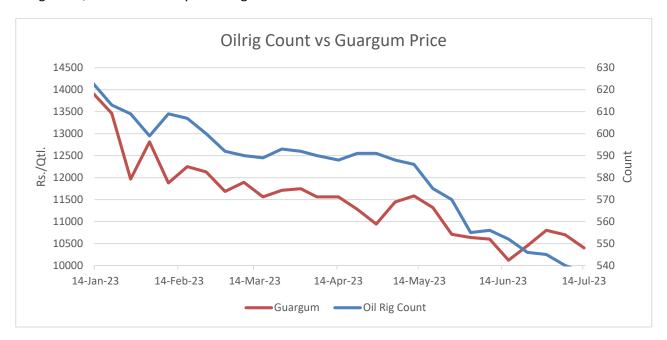
WTI Crude Oil

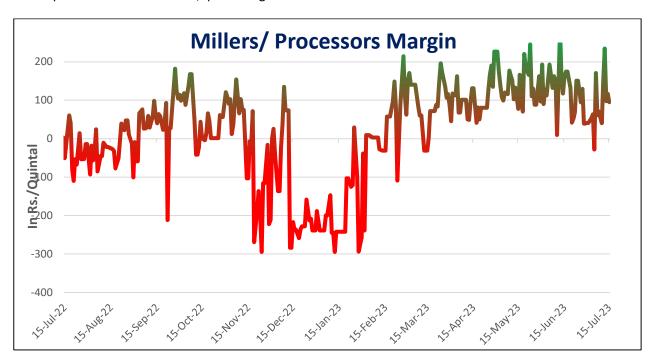
Oil Rig Count (Baker Hughes)

As per the data released by Baker Hughes, as on 14th July '2023, the U.S. oil rigs fell by 3 to 537 this week as compared to 540 in the previous week, lowest since April' 22 amid the low crude oil price. If we look at this year's oilrig count, it is continuously declining due to lesser demand of crude oil.



Millers/Processors Margin

During the week under review, weekly average net crush margin of Guar seed went up at INR 116/qtl. as compared to the previous week at INR 60/qtl. amid good domestic demand in the market.
