

Soy Meal Fundamentals: Soy meal FOR (Kandla) featured mild gains and quoted at Rs.30,125/MT compared to Rs. 30,000/MT on Thursday.

India's oilmeal shipments in October more than doubled from a September to 218,307 tonnes due to increase in rapeseed meal exports to South Korea and Thailand. The Export of soy meal during October 2014 was just 29,690 tones as compared to 1,94,486 tones during the same period last year.

On a financial year basis, the export during current financial year i.e. April 2014 to October 2014 is 1.27 Lac tones as compared to 10.71 Lac tones in the same period of previous year showing a decrease of approx. 88%.

Country's soy meal exports improved to 29071 tonnes in October from 868 tonnes in September, the Solvent Extractors' Association of India.

Of the total oilmeal shipments in October, soy meal comprised of 29,071 tonnes, rapeseed meal (13,33,93 tonnes), ricebran extraction (31,25 tonnes) and castorseed meal was 52,718 tonnes.
