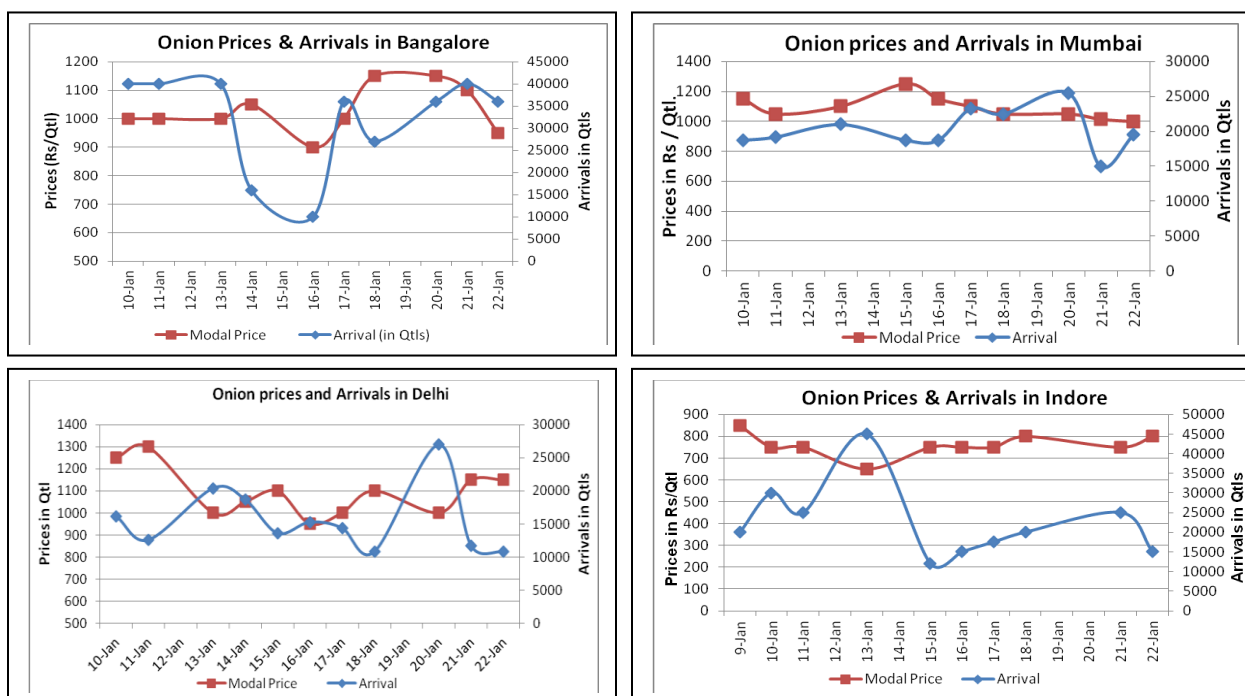


Onion Fundamentals:

- Harvesting of late kharif onion has started from beginning of January and will continue till March end and may extend upto early April.
- As per state Govt estimate, this year late kharif acreage is 1.28 lakh hectares. Normal acreage of late kharif onion is 95000 hectares.
- Late kharif arrivals have started arriving in market from Maharashtra and few parts of Gujarat. According to trade sources approximately 5-6% of kharif onion is left in Maharashtra.
- In Delhi, wholesale prices are in the range of Rs 700 to Rs 1300/ quintal whereas prices in retail market are in the range of Rs 2000/ quintal.
