


### Daily Onion Report 1 February 2014

### **Onion Fundamentals:**

- Mostly Onion arrivals were reported lower in major domestic market on Friday.
- Harvesting of late kharif onion has started from beginning of January and will continue till March end and may extend up to early April.
- As per state Government estimate, this year late kharif acreage is 1.28 lakh hectares. Normal acreage of late kharif onion is 95000 hectares.
- In Maharashtra transplanting of Rabi onion which has started from end of Nov and will continue till January end.
- Total production of late kharif onion is expected to be 22-23 Lakh ton with average yield of 20.10 ton/ha.
- Harvest timing of late kharif onion is as follows- Jan: 25-30%, Feb: 30-35%, March: 30-32% and April: 5-10%.
- In Delhi, wholesale modal prices are ranging in the range of Rs 800-Rs 1300/ quintal whereas retail prices are in the range of Rs 2200/ quintal.
