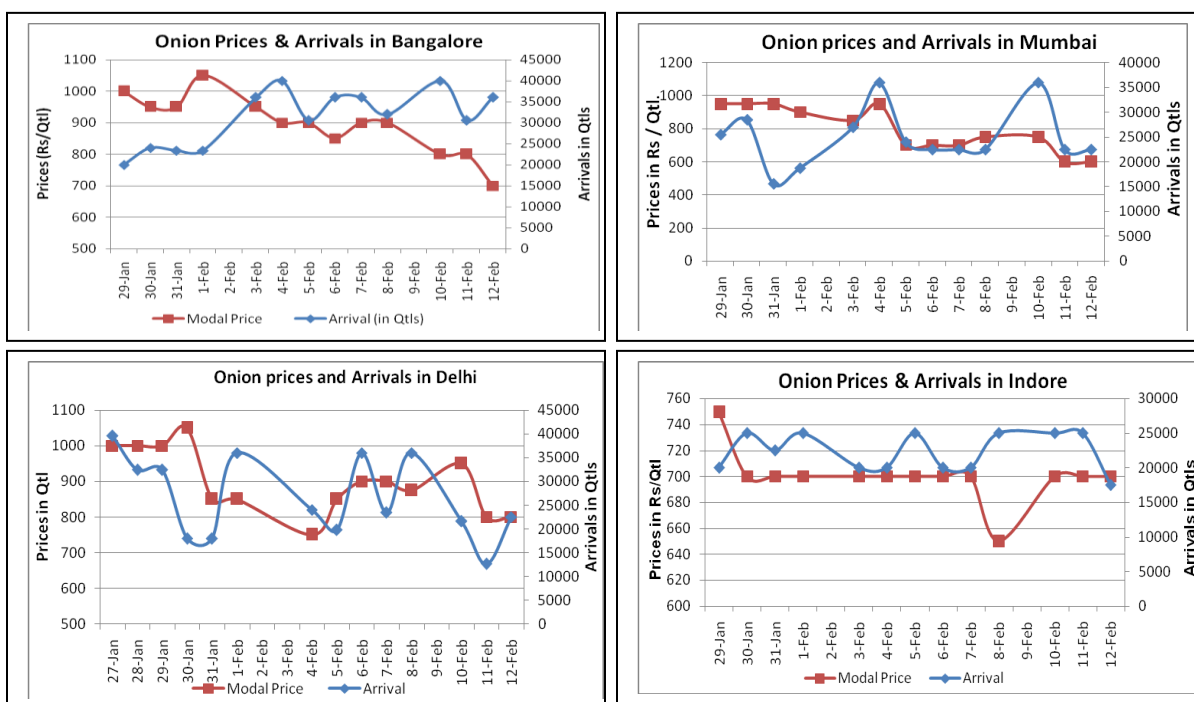


Onion Fundamentals:

- Higher arrivals in some major domestic market put cap on prices.
- In Delhi, wholesale modal prices are ranging in the range of Rs 600-Rs 800/ quintal whereas retail price reported steady to Rs 2200/ quintal.
- Onion transplanting almost completed in major growing region.
- In Karnataka, Rabi sowing is almost completed in 28078 hectares of the total targeted area of 21967 hectares as on 03.02.2014 as compared to the last year 4191 hectares. In Chitradurga and Bijapur districts which are major producing region.
- Rabi crop arrivals may come to the market by March - April in all parts of the country. The Rabi crop is expected to be about 25% higher than the previous year.
- Sources revealed that, in 2013 -14, total onion production may touch 190 lakh tonne however, in 2012 - 13, it was 168 lakh tonne.
