



Onion Fundamentals:


- All India Onion arrival in 3rd week of February is 26% less compared to previous week. If we compare arrivals on a yearly basis it is 21% higher than last year during same time.
- In Bangalore, 40% of onion is arriving in market from Gulbarga and Chitradurga district. Rest 60% of onion is arriving in market from Maharashtra region.
- In Delhi, onion is arriving in market majorly from Gujarat and Maharashtra region and from few parts of M.P and Rajasthan. Onion from Maharashtra is able to fetch maximum price in the range of Rs 1000- Rs 1250/ quintal.
- In Indore, arrivals have fallen more than 60% because of heavy rainfall which led to decline in arrivals sharply.
