



Onion Fundamentals:


- In Lasalgaon, average arrivals are almost similar to previous week whereas modal prices have increased to Rs 820/ quintal from Rs 790/ quintal.
- In Bangalore, onion is arriving in market from local region (Gulbarga and Chitradurga districts) and Maharashtra region which are contributing approximately 50% each.
- In Delhi, onion crop is mainly coming from Gujarat, Maharashtra and Rajasthan which are contributing approximately 55%, 35% and 10% respectively to the total arrival.
- Minimum Export Price (MEP) on onion has removed because of sharp reduction in onion prices and to boost onion export.
