



Onion Fundamentals:


- Mostly firm sentiment witnessed in Onion major domestic market on Saturday.
- As per trade sources, onion prices may likely to go up in coming days due to crop loss in MP and Maharashtra region.
- In Delhi market arrivals coming from Rajasthan and Gujarat region.
- As per Agriwatch ongoing survey, in Nasik region early harvesting reported a minimum of 10 15 days because of higher water content. Rabi crop damaged reported in Nasik and Satara districts, yields were affected as compared to the last year. Farmers were reported Onion standing crop affected 30 – 40 percent in some particular districts due to recent rain.
- The Director General of Foreign Trade (DGFT) issued a notification to free onion exports by anyone. In earlier days Nafed was the only canalising agency till 1999. Further 12 State Trading Enterprises (STEs) along with Nafed were designated by the government as the canalising agencies for export of onion only.
