


### **Onion Fundamentals:**


- Mixed sentiment witnessed in Mumbai and Delhi market on Friday, Indore and Bangalore market reported closed May Day.
- In Karnataka, Gujarat and other smaller states production is higher this year. Lower production in Maharashtra seems to be compensated by higher supply from other major states.
- Storage in Maharashtra will be clear by end of May month as farmers were not ready to store much at this time due to higher water content and upper layer of onion bulb being damaged.
- In benchmark market of Lasalgaon, prices have increased by 15% compared to previous week whereas arrivals have fallen by approximately 30% compared to previous week.
- Average yield in Maharashtra is estimated to be near 13-14 ton/ha after considering crop damage.
- As per IBIS (International Business Information System), approximately 48,400 tons of processed and fresh onion has been exported in month of April 2014 as on 27<sup>th</sup> April.
