




Onion Fundamentals:


- Onion arrivals were reported up on Monday.
- Onion prices likely to go up after 20 June due to shortage of supply. Onion traders expect lower production amid poor quality arrivals might support the bullish sentiment in coming days.
- In Kanpur domestic market higher Onion demand coming from Assam and West Bengal region and Bangladesh.
- All India, rabi onion storage is expected to be less this year compared to previous year because shelf life
 of onion have declined this year to higher content of water in onion crop which was due to unseasonal
 rains and hailstorms.
- As per IBIS (International Business Information System), approximately 45500 tons of processed and fresh onion has been exported in month of May 2014 as on 9th May. It includes the exports which are exported through sea routes only and do not include exports through roads.
