
Onion Fundamentals:

- Mixed sentiment witnessed in Onion major domestic market on Monday. In Bangalore mandi higher arrivals reported as new crop arrivals started coming from Hassan region.
- In Karnataka, Onion sowing as on 30-07-2014, 65857 hectares covered as compared to the last year same period 70083 hectares. Highest area reported Hassan, Chikmagalur, Dharwad, Belgaum etc.
- In Delhi, as per consumer affairs data wholesale modal prices are hovering around Rs 1725/ quintal whereas retail prices are in the range of Rs 3100/ quintal.
- Sources revealed that, Onion prices likely to go down due to higher stocks available in the domestic market.
- Exporters were reported unresponsive due to higher MEP prices (\$ 500/ ton.) and quality issue. Quality of Pakistan onion is quite good compared to Indian onion.
