
Onion Fundamentals:

- In Delhi, wholesale prices are Rs 1638/ quintal. Onion is arriving in market from Rajasthan, Gujarat, Maharashtra and few parts of Haryana.
- In Maharashtra, arrivals are 25% less in second week of December month compared to previous year because of continuous rains which was a constraint to total arrivals.
- In Karnataka, onion is arriving in market from local region and Maharashtra which are contributing approximately 70% and 30% respectively.
- As per IBIS (International Business Information Services), approximately 11782 tons of processed and fresh onion has been exported in 2nd week of December. This export contains both Air and Sea route.
