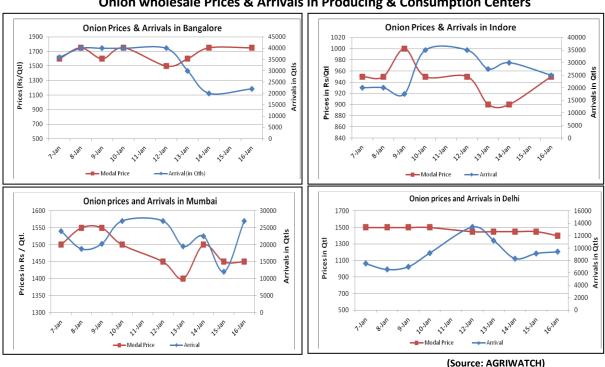
Onion Fundamentals:

- Mixed sentiment witnessed in Onion domestic market on Friday.
- All India Rabi sowing is estimated to be 5-10% less compared to previous year. Maximum fall in acreage could be seen in Maharashtra due to less water and lower price.
- In Bangalore, lower onion arrival reported due to occasion of Makarsakranti as 60% of total crop arriving in market comes from local region.
- In Maharashtra, Rabi acreage is estimated to be 10-15% lower than last year due to lower rains.
- In Delhi, wholesale prices are Rs 1175/ quintal. Onion is arriving in market from M.P., Rajasthan, Gujarat, Maharashtra and few parts of Haryana. Maximum prices are being fetched by Maharashtra onion and lowest prices are of Rajasthan onion.
