

#### **Onion Fundamentals:**


- Lower supply reported in major Onion market on Monday.
- In M.P, Onion area reported down due to less availability of water and crop shifting to potato and coriander seed as price of these commodities were ruling higher during sowing time.
- In Lasalgaon, modal prices are trading in the range of Rs 1000/ quintal from last few days and arrivals are higher due to peak harvesting Rabi season.
- In M.P, local produced onion is arriving in market and traders are expecting onion crop 5-10% lower compared to previous year.
- In Maharashtra, average yield of this Rabi season is estimated to be 17.47 ton/ha against after considering the crop damage. Prior to rains & hailstorms, farmers average yield expectation was 21.5 ton/ha which is a good yield.
