
Onion Fundamentals:

- In Delhi, onion is arriving in market from Indore, Nasik, Rajasthan and Haryana. Maximum prices are being fetched by Nasik onion and lowest prices are of Rajasthan onion.
- According to trade sources in Maharashtra, shelf life of onion has reduced to 3-4 months this year from
 6-7 months due to rains and hailstorms during harvesting time.
- Onion prices are comparatively higher than last year in both wholesale and retail market because of crop damaged during harvesting time in producing regions.
- In Maharashtra, kharif onion transplanting may decrease due to delay in monsoon. But if monsoon is timely and proper kharif area may increase due to higher prices this year.
