


### **Onion Fundamentals:**


- In Maharashtra, kharif onion transplanting may decrease due to delay in monsoon. But if monsoon is timely and proper, kharif area may increase due to higher prices this year.
- According to trade sources in Maharashtra, shelf life of onion has reduced to 3-4 months this year from
  6-7 months due to rains and hailstorms during harvesting time.
- Onion prices are comparatively higher than last year during same time because of crop loss in producing regions and low shelf life of Onion this year.
- According to Agriwatch survey in Jalgaon district, crop loss is reported in a range of 30% -70% and stored crop is comparatively lower than last year.
