Executive Summary:

- All India onion arrivals in the month of August are approximately 25.73% lower compared to the previous month. If we compare onion arrivals in August month on a yearly basis we observed that arrivals are 28.43% lower than last year during same time.
- In Karnataka, approximately 92354.8 hectares of area is sown as on 31.8.2015 compared to last year's area of 108782 hectares.
- In A.P, as on 02.9.2015 normal area is 20930 hectares but so far 24278 hectares of area is sown compared to last year's 22663 hectares during same time.
- Total onion production in Kharif season (kharif + late kharif) is expected to be between 48-50 lakh tons. If further rainfall happens in Maharashtra and Karnataka it may increase the prospect of late kharif crop.
- To curb down the rising prices in domestic markets and to discourage exports, government increased the MEP to \$ 700/ ton from \$ 425/ton on 24-8-2015.
- Across the country prices of onion are coming down from last one week due to strict decision taken by Government against exports, hoarders and import of onion. Secondly fresh crop from A.P and Karnataka and availability of imported onion.
- As per IBIS (International Business Information Services), approximately 12,723 tons of processed and fresh onion has been exported in month of August 2015 compared to export of 43,366 tons in July. It includes only sea route.

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On a month-on-month basis, wholesale prices have increased in almost all the markets. Prices have increased because of lesser arrivals in market. Prices if compared to last year are higher in almost all the markets.

Arrivals are also lower than last year in major markets except Hyderabad and Bangalore where local produced fresh crop is available in market.

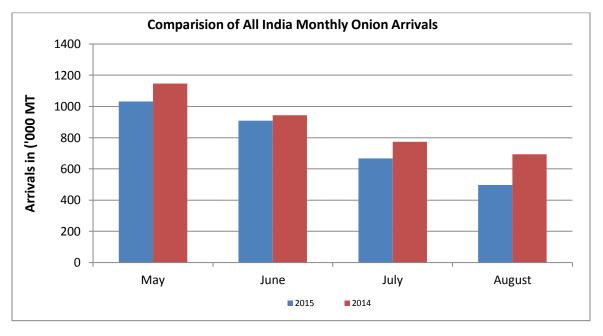

In Retail markets, prices have increased compared to previous month and previous year. Prices are expected to ease down in coming months with increase in arrival of kharif crop. Prices if compared to previous year are much higher this year due to lower arrivals in producing regions. Prices are expected to come down in coming days.





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All India Onion Monthly Arrivals:

The above graph shows the monthly all India onion arrivals. Arrivals are lower in August month compared to previous month and also compared to the previous year. Arrivals are expected to increase slightly in coming days as fresh kharif may pick up pace.

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The above table gives a comparison between cumulative rainfalls this year and last year. Rainfall is deficit in almost all onion growing districts of Maharashtra and Karnataka. Improved rainfall in coming weeks may increase the intention of late kharif crop sowing in producing regions. Lower rainfall would lead to lesser acreage under late Kharif onion with transplantation also getting delayed. Yield could also get affected due to shortage of water for Kharif onion.



Technical Analysis of Onion Prices at Lasalgaon, Nasik:

(Note: Each bar or "candle" in the chart shows the price movement in a particular month. The green candle signifies prices increased and red candle signifies prices decreased in that week. The length of the "candle" shows the upper and lower end of the price range for the week.)

The above chart shows the monthly price movement of onion in the benchmark of Lasalgaon mandi of Nasik. During the month of August, average modal prices were around Rs 4144/ quintal compared to previous month's Rs 2076/ quintal. Prices in August month closed near Rs.4600/quintal. On the upper side, prices may find resistance at a level of Rs 5400/ quintal whereas support is at Rs 3900/ quintal and followed by 3300/ quintal. Overall, onion prices are expected to come down in the coming months as Relative strength indicator (RSI) oscillator is in overbought zone and may start coming down in coming days.
