

Potato Fundamentals:

- In West Bengal, late blight disease is seen in some parts but it would be nominal as potato area is 10-15% higher than last year.
- According to trade sources in West Bengal, potato prices are expected to remain lower this year due to higher production in the State and other supplying States like Orissa.
- In Bangalore, potato is arriving in market from Indore, Hyderabad and local region. Local region potato is contributing approximately 45% to total arrival.
- In Delhi, Potato is arriving in market from U.P, Punjab and Haryana. Wholesale and retail prices are trading around Rs 638 and Rs 1400/ quintal respectively.
