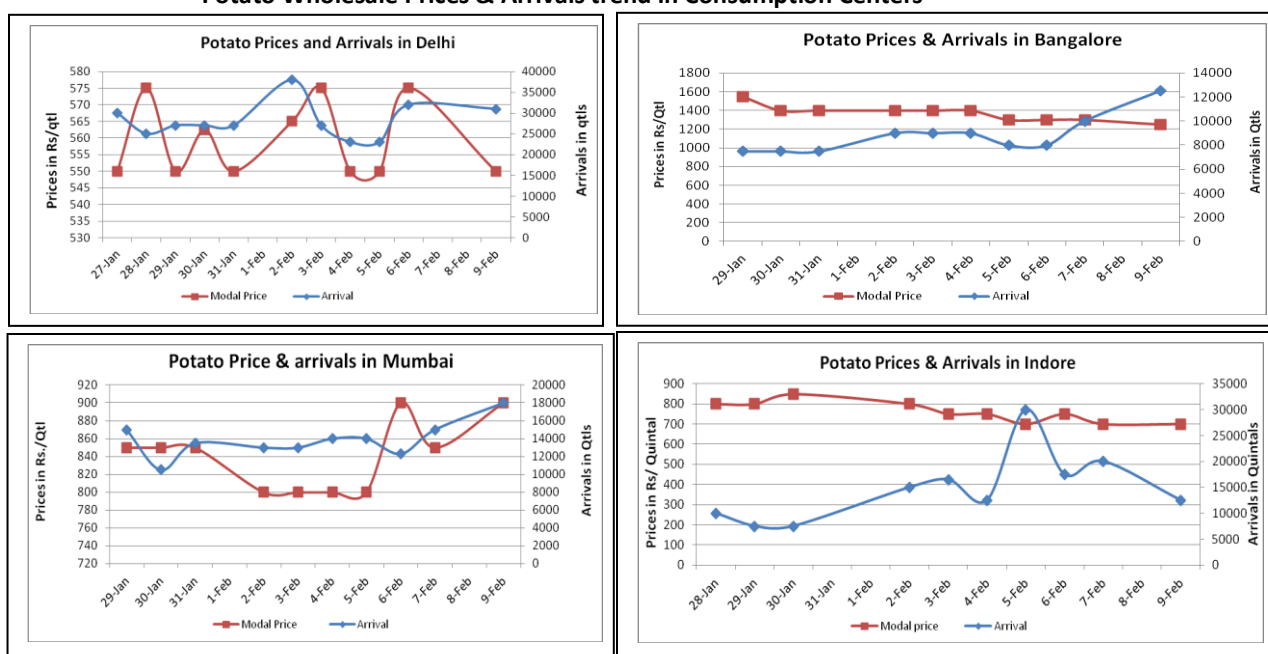


Potato Fundamentals:

- In West Bengal, cold storages are expected to open from 1st week of March which is normal time.
- West Bengal traders are expecting lower demand from Orissa which is major supplying centre for West Bengal due to higher production in Orissa.
- In Bangalore, potato is arriving in market from Indore, Hyderabad and local region. Local region potato is contributing approximately 45% to total arrival.
- In Delhi, Potato is arriving in market from U.P, Punjab and Haryana. Wholesale and retail prices are trading around Rs 650 and Rs 1400/ quintal respectively.
