
Market Intelligence System

Potato Fundamentals:

- Lower supply reported in Delhi and Indore market on Thursday. Bangalore and Mumbai market closed due to Holi festival.
- In Punjab, unseasonal rains have affected the crop by 5-10%. This year total sown area was approximately 85000 hectares. So far approximately 40% of crop has been harvested so far.
- In A.P, Potato area is similar to previous year. Major growing districts are Vishakapatnam and Chittor.
- In West Bengal, cold storage loading is started and average loading price are trading in a range of Rs 180-Rs 220/ packet (50 kg).
- According to trade sources in West Bengal, cold storage are expected to use 100% utilization this year compared to last year utilization of 86%.
- In U.P, cold storages loading prices are approximately Rs 400 to Rs 500/ quintal.
