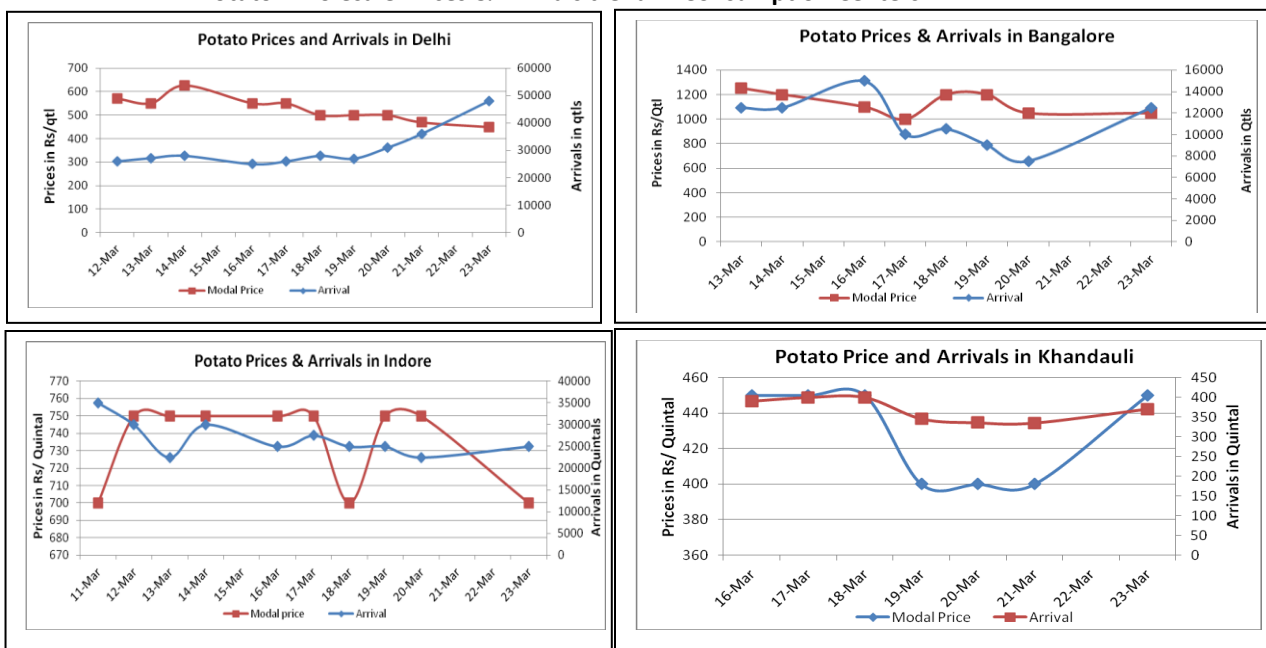


Potato Fundamentals:

- In West Bengal, on a daily basis approximately 5-6% loading of potatoes is completing.
- In Bihar average Loading prices are trading in the range of Rs 600- Rs 650/ quintal. Traders are expecting 100% utilization
- In U.P, cold storages loading may extend to first week of April due to delay in harvesting because of rains in previous weeks.
- Arrivals have increased in all the markets because of good weather condition and loading in cold storage is at higher pace.
