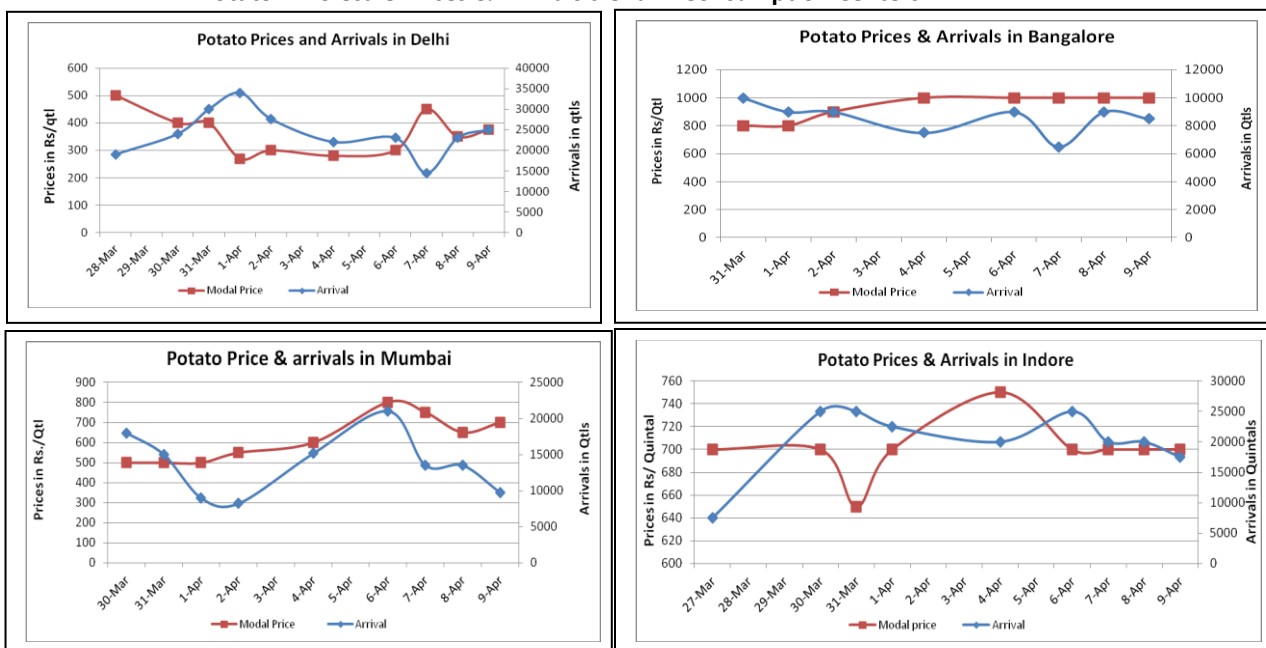


Potato Fundamentals:

- In U.P, loading is almost completed with 100% utilization. Traders are expecting cold storages to close in next few days.
- In West Bengal, traders are expecting that cold storages may open after mid May.
- In Bihar average loading prices are trading in the range of Rs 550- Rs 650/ quintal compared to last year Rs 998/quintal.
- Across the country prices are expected to be lower throughout the season as cold storages are filled with 100% utilization in all producing regions. Secondly this year loading prices are much lower than last year.
