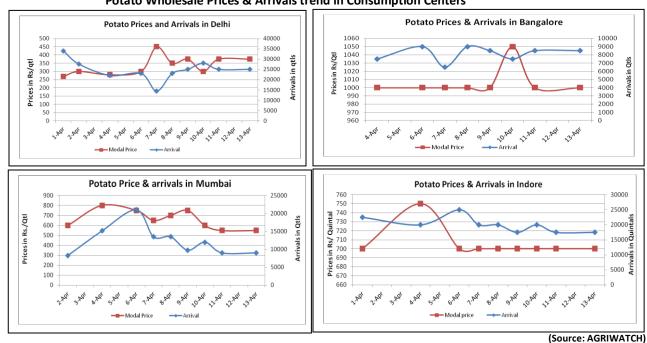
Potato Fundamentals:

- Punjab Government has announced a subsidy of Rs 50/ quintal on freight for selling potatoes to other
 States. Market fee has also reduced to .25% from 2%
- In U.P, loading is almost completed with 100% utilization. Traders are expecting cold storages to close in next few days.
- In West Bengal, traders are expecting that cold storages may open after mid May.
- In Bihar average loading prices are trading in the range of Rs 550- Rs 650/ quintal compared to last year Rs 998/quintal.
