

Potato Fundamentals:

- In Bihar, cold storage capacity utilization is approximately 100% with a total capacity of 11.12 lakh tons.
- In West Bengal cold storages have utilized 100% capacity utilization with a total storage capacity of 62.52 lakh tons.
- In West Bengal, state government has decided to provide railway freight subsidy of Rs 50 per quintal to potato shipment from south Bengal, and Rs 100 a quintal from north Bengal
- Punjab Government has announced a subsidy of Rs 50/ quintal on freight for selling potatoes to other States. Market fee has also reduced to .25% from 2%
