
Potato Fundamentals:

- In West Bengal traders are expecting cold storages to open from last week of May month. Normally cold storages open in 1st week of May but this year due to higher production release from cold storages is delayed.
- In West Bengal, state government has decided to provide railway freight subsidy of Rs 50 per quintal to potato shipment from south Bengal, and Rs 100 a quintal from north Bengal.
- In Bihar, traders are expecting cold storages to open at a minimum price of Rs 1000/ quintal.
- Punjab Government has announced a subsidy of Rs 50/ quintal on freight for selling potatoes to other States. Market fee has also reduced to .25% from 2%.
