
Potato Fundamentals:

- In West Bengal traders are expecting cold storages to open from last week of May month. Normally cold storages open in 1st week of May but this year due to higher production release from cold storages is delayed.
- In West Bengal, traders are expecting cold storages to open with prices of Rs 600-Rs 650/ quintal.
- In Bihar, traders are expecting cold storages to open at a minimum price of Rs 1000/ quintal.
- In Delhi, modal prices are hovering in the range of Rs 488/ quintal compared to last year Rs 1250/ quintal during same time.
