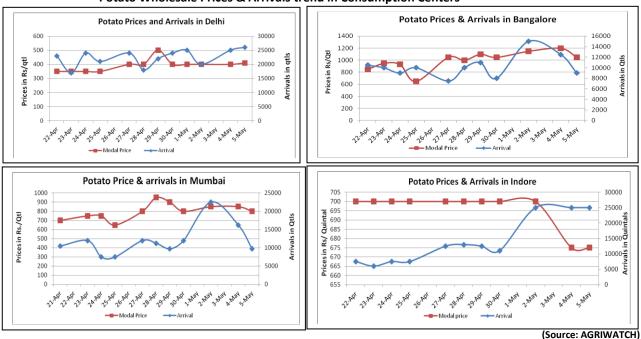
Potato Fundamentals:

- Weak sentiment witnessed in Potato domestic market on Tuesday.
- Lower supply reported in the major domestic market during the period. However, in Delhi market higher supply reported, arrivals mainly coming from UP and Punjab.
- In West Bengal, traders are expecting cold storages to open with prices of Rs 600-Rs 650/ quintal.
- In Delhi, modal prices are hovering in the range of Rs 475/ quintal compared to last year Rs 1200/ quintal during same time.
- In Bihar, traders are expecting cold storages to open at a minimum price of Rs 1000/ quintal.
- In West Bengal traders are expecting cold storages to open from last week of May month. Normally cold storages open in 1st week of May but this year due to higher production release from cold storages is delayed.
