

Potato Fundamentals:

- Lower supply reported in Potato domestic market on Wednesday.
- As per IBIS (International Business Information Services) around 1734 tons of Potato has been exported during 4th May – 10th May 2015.
- Potato cold storage filled by 100% due to increased production in India. In West Bengal, current year cold storage stocks reported around 70 lakh MT as compared to the last year 57.5 Lakh MT.
- Cold stores are opened in UP and West Bengal but pace of release is very slow due to lower prevailing prices and potato stocks in open places.
- Farmers are unwilling to sell from cold stores at these prices and waiting for prices to rise. Release will gather pace in 7-10 days once stock in open space is exhausted.
