
# **Market Intelligence System**

## Potato Fundamentals:

- In West Bengal, potato prices have increased by Rs 40- 50/ quintal and trading in the range of Rs 580-640/ quintal due to continuous rains from last 5-6 days which has affected the supply.
- In Bangalore, crop from Hassan has started arriving in market in smaller quantity. Traders are expecting full fledge arrivals from Hassan in couple of weeks.
- According to trade sources in producing regions like West Bengal and U.P, traders are expecting lower demand and fall in prices once crop from Hassan starts arriving in market with full pace.
- In West Bengal, so far approximately 30 % potatoes have been released compared to last year release of 40% during same time. Traders are expecting lower demand in coming months
