



### **Potato Fundamentals:**


- In Agra (Khandauli), modal prices are trading at Rs 575/ quintal compared to last year's price of Rs 2200/ quintal during same time.
- In West Bengal, prices are trading at Rs 620/ quintal compared to previous year price of Rs 1600- Rs 1700/ quintal during same time.
- In Bangalore, approximately 60% fresh potato from Hassan is arriving in market and rest of the potato is coming from cold storages of U.P. Hassan crop is expected to arrive in market for next two weeks.
- In West Bengal, so far approximately 42 % potatoes have been released. Normally release by this time should be 50%. This year storage was approximately 21% higher than last year.
