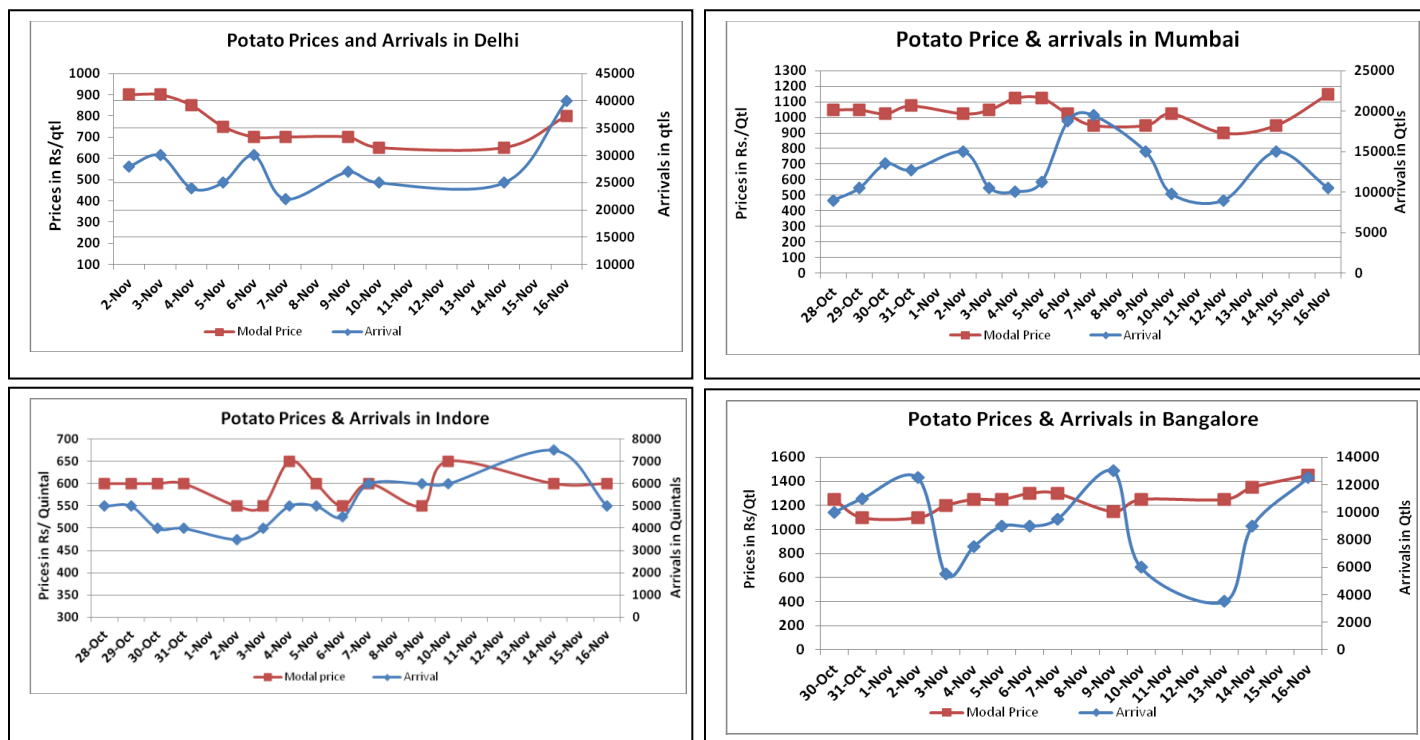


## Potato Fundamentals:

- In Delhi, fresh crop from Punjab is trading at Rs 1200- Rs 1400/ quintal. Fresh crop from Punjab is fetching higher prices compared to stored potatoes.
- According to trade sources, fresh crop from Punjab has started arriving in market. According to trade sources crop condition is good this year.
- In West Bengal, approximately 76% potatoes have been released compared to last year release of 83% during this time.
- In U.P, approximately 76% potato has been released from the cold storages which is almost similar to last year.
