Executive Summary:

- In U.P, average loading prices are approximately Rs 400-Rs 450/ quintal compared to last year Rs 950/ quintal which directly indicate higher production in U.P.
- Amid higher production Punjab Government has given freight subsidy of Rs 200/quintal through Marked for export of potatoes to other countries and Rs 50 per quintal for marketing the crop in other states. The State has also slashed the market fee from 2 to 0.25%.
- In West Bengal, state government has decided to provide railway freight subsidy of Rs 50 per quintal to potato shipment from south Bengal, and Rs 100 a quintal from north Bengal.
- In West Bengal traders are expecting cold storages to open from last week of May month. Normally cold storages open in 2nd week of May but this year due to higher production release from cold storages is delayed. Traders are expecting cold storages to open with prices of Rs 600-Rs 650/ quintal.
- In Bihar, traders are expecting cold storages to open at a minimum price of Rs 1000/ quintal. Average loading prices are trading in the range of Rs 550- Rs 650/ quintal compared to last year Rs 998/quintal.
- Prices are expected to remain lower this year due to higher production and almost 100% capacity utilization of cold storages in producing regions. Average loading prices in cold storages were almost half of the last year in all the producing regions.

Technical Analysis Potato Spot Market (Khandauli, Agra):



(Note: Each bar or "candle" in the chart shows the price movement in a particular month. The blue candle signifies prices increased and red candle signifies prices decreased in that month. The length of the "candle" shows the upper and lower end of the price range for the week.)

The above chart shows the monthly price movement of potato for Agra (Khandauli) market. Modal prices are trading at Rs 300-350/quintal. On the higher side prices may find long term resistance at a level of 700/quintal. On the lower side prices may find long term support at a level of Rs 200/quintal. Relative strength Indicator (RSI) oscillator is also moving downward in oversold region and indicates that prices may remain lower in coming months. Overall potato market is expected to be bearish this year due to higher production.
