

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- According to latest update, due to falling prices of guar farmers have shown interest of shifting from guar to moong in this kharif season. The price of guar has already decreased to Rs 55 per kg from Rs 120 per kg in 2015 which has led to a fall in exports by 57% for 2015-16. Whereas pulses are in uptrend and farmers will realize more from pulses as compared to guar.
- According to latest update, in order to keep prices in check and improve domestic supply the centre has approved tenders for importing 7500 tonnes of pulses specially Tur and Urad. The tenders will be issued through MMTC for 2500 tons of Tur and 5000 tonnes of Urad.
- Odisha Traders Association has called off strike on VAT issue after getting written assurance from state government. The traders were on strike on April 1 to protest against the 5 percent Value Addition Tax (VAT) levied by the Odisha government on the purchase of pulses from other states. They have suspended their strike till 26, May 2016.
- Moong prices have shown some firmness due to demand from local millers. At present, prices of Moong are around Rs 6900 per bag with arrival of 1500-1600 bags per day in Merta City mandi of Rajasthan. Stockiest have stocked Moong around Rs 8000 per quintal and still they are holding their stock in expectation of higher prices in future.
- According to the local trader of Kanpur region of Uttar Pradesh, pea yield this year is lower than last year due to lower rainfall. Arrival from new pea crop has started and it would continue to increase in coming weeks. Quality is normal. At present arrival in the mandi is around 2000-3000 bags per day with price range of Rs 3200-3250 per bag.
- According to the local trader of Bikaner region of Rajasthan, Chana arrival may increase in coming days due to starting of new financial year and prevailing higher current prices. Closure of markets due to year end too had restricted arrivals. At present, prices of chana in the mandi is hovering in the range of Rs 4200-4400 per quintal with arrival of 15000-20000 bags per day.
- According to the local trader of Akola region of Maharashtra, farmers are still holding good amount of Tur in expectation of getting higher prices in future. At present, price of Tur is in the range of Rs 8300-8400 per quintal with arrival of 1000 bags per day. According to Agriwatch, with expected higher arrival and correction in imported tur quotes, market is likely to trade stable to slightly weak in coming days. Supply side is expected to be higher than last 1-2 weeks and it may impact inner tone in the cash market in the short term.
- According to IBIS (provisional data), import of pulses in the week (14 Mar-20 Mar) was around 78 Thousand tonnes at major ports in India, around 48% higher than previous week's (07 Mar-13 Mar) import of 53 Thousand tonnes. Cow Pea, Kidney Bean, Masoor and Pigeon Pea were imported lower this week whereas Chana, Moong, Urad Green Pea and Yellow Pea were imported higher as compared to last week.
- In order to create buffer stock of pulses, HAFED will Procure Chana on behalf of NAFED in Haryana. Haryana gram production estimate is around 1.05 Lakh tonnes and arrivals are expected from mid April. If prices decreases or comes around MSP, government would buy Chana paying Rs 75 per quintal over and above MSP.
- The WPI has fallen from 370.1 in January 2016 to 356.4 in February 2016 for pulses. There has been a considerable fall in WPI of Lentil (347.1 for January 2016 and 337.2 for February 2016) and Moong (413.6 for January 2016 and 397.4 for February 2016), whereas the fall in WPI of urad has been marginal (507.8 for January 2016 and 507.1 for February 2016).

Pulses International Fundamental:

- **According to latest report by USDA, farmers in the US expect to plant Chickpeas in larger area** as compared to last year due to strong prices and demand. The area for small chickpeas is expected increase by 15% to 83000 acres and area for large chickpeas is expected to increase by 20% to 163000 acres in 2016.
- **According to latest update**, carry-out stocks for Canadian Chickpeas are expected to fall from 125 thousand MT in 2014-15 to 50 thousand MT 2015-16. This fall in carry-out stocks is mainly due to increased exports and decreased production
- **According to Agri Market experts**, Burma pigeon peas are being offered at USD 1140 CFR Mumbai for April shipment. Traders are offering Green mung Beans from Argentina at USD 980-1000 CFR Nhava Sheva for May/June shipment and Kabuli Chickpeas 9 MM from Argentina is being offered at USD 960 CFR Nhava Sheva for April shipment.
- **According to the latest Statpub report, France pea export increased by 66%** to 10.0 Thousand MT in January from previous month of 6.01 Thousand MT. However, it is 23% lower than 13,030 MT shipped during the same month last year. This year export of peas from France is expected to increase.
- **According to the latest report, Canadian Lentil production for 2015-16 increases by around 19%** to 2.4 MMT. Last year it was 1.98 MMT. Due to higher production and good demand, exports are forecasted to reach 2.4 MMT from 2.1 MMT. Season ending stock is expected to decrease from 0.36 MMT to 0.10 MMT. Farmer's average bids are likely to increase from \$585 to \$880/910 per tonnes due to higher demand, less availability of good quality crop and weak Canadian dollar.
- **According to the latest report, Canada Chickpea Production for 2015-16 decreases by around 31 percent** to 0.90 MMT. Canada had produced 1.31 MMT last year. Despite lower production, exports are forecasted to reach 0.85 MMT this year from 0.80 MMT last year due to higher demand. However, season ending stock is expected to decrease from 0.125 MMT to 0.075 MMT .Farmers bids are likely to increase from \$515 to \$685-715 per tonne.
- **According to the latest report, Canada Pea Production for 2015-16 decreases by around 16 percent** to 3.2 MMT. Canada had produced 3.8 MMT last year. Due to lower production, exports are forecasted to reach 2.95 MMT this year from 3.04 MMT last year. Farmer's bids are likely to increase from \$260 to \$305-335 per tonne due to good demand.
- **According to the latest ABARES report, Australian Chickpea production forecast 2015-16** is 1013 kilo tonnes which are around 82% greater than 2014-15 estimate which was 555 kilo tonnes. Australian chickpea harvesting starts from mid September and crops start hitting India market from October onwards.
- **According to latest Canadian update**, for 2016-17 sowing area for lentils in Canada is expected to increase up to 1.8Mha. Furthermore, higher yield is also expected which will lead to increase in production by 20% to 2.85 Mt which is up by 0.57Mt in 2015-16.
- **According to latest Canadian update**, exports for chickpeas are expected to increase from 2014-15 because of increase in demand from Pakistan and US. USDA has estimated US chickpea production at 114 kilotonnes, which is about 10% lower than 2014-15. The average prices can also increase due to higher local demand and higher quotes in international market.
