

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- According to the local trader of Kanpur region of Uttar Pradesh, new pea crop has increased due to higher prices in the cash market. Demand of pea is higher than normal and crop quality is good. At present arrival in the mandi is around 3000-4000 bags per day with price range of Rs 3340-3370 per bag.
- According to the third advance estimate, Rajasthan agriculture Department lowers down chana production estimate to 9.99 Lakh tones which is 17% lower than targeted estimate. Targeted estimate was 12.07 Lakh tonnes. Lower production estimate and good demand has given support to chana cash market.
- According to the local trader of Bikaner region of Rajasthan, Chana arrivals is around 20-25 percent lower than the last year. Demand is good and stockiest and companies are active in the market giving support to the cash market. At present, prices of Chana in Bikaner Mandi are around Rs 5000 per quintal with arrival of 14000-15000 bags per day.
- According to IBIS (provisional data), import of pulses in the week (04 Apr-10 Apr) was around 88 Thousand tonnes at major ports in India, around 80% higher than previous week's (28 Mar-03 Apr) import of 49 Thousand tonnes. Chana, Moong, Urad Green Pea Kidney Bean and Masoor were imported lower this week whereas Cow Pea, Pigeon Pea and Yellow Pea were imported higher as compared to last week.
- According to IBIS, India green pea imports was around 2877 MT in last week (04 Apr-10 Apr) at an average price of \$ 406.70 Cif per tonne. Major exporters were Canada and USA. At present Green Pea price in Mumbai market is going around Rs 3000-3200 per quintal. Green Pea price may show steady to slightly firm movement due to good demand.
- Urad prices continue to trade firm in the cash market due to higher demand. Imports of Urad from Burma is weak than demand and arrival in major mandi is lower than expected which too support the cash market. Stock is negligible with traders due to higher quotes; all these factors push the Urad price northward.
- According to the local trader of Latur region of Maharashtra, Chana crop quality is good this year. However, arrival is lower than last year. At present, Chana prices in Latur mandi is around Rs 4950-5050 per quintal with arrival of around 9000-10000 bags per day.
- Masoor Crop in Patna region starts hitting the mandi. Arrival pressure is lower than last year even though yield is higher than last year as farmers are holding the crop in expectation of getting higher prices in the future. Crop and quality is good and moisture level is higher around 15-16 %. At present, masoor prices in Patna mandi is around Rs 62000-6250 per bag with arrival of 900-1000 bags per day.
- Local Masoor crop start hitting Kanpur mandi in small amount in Kanpur region of Uttar Pradesh and grain quality is good. Demand of masoor is good as stockiest are taking this crop for storage. At present, Masoor prices in Kanpur mandi is around Rs 6000-6200 per quintal with arrival of around 500-600 bags per day.
- According to the local trader of Vijayawada region of Andhra Pradesh, urad farmers are holding their crops in expectation of getting higher prices in future. Urad prices are had increased due to good demand and lower production estimate of Kharif crop. At present, urad prices in Vijayawada mandi is around Rs 11800-12000 per quintal with arrival of around 10000-12000 bags per day.

Pulses International Fundamental:

- **According to latest report by USDA, farmers in the US expect to plant Chickpeas in larger area** as compared to last year due to strong prices and demand. The area for small chickpeas is expected increase by 15% to 83000 acres and area for large chickpeas is expected to increase by 20% to 163000 acres in 2016.
- **According to latest update**, carry-out stocks for Canadian Chickpeas are expected to fall from 125 thousand MT in 2014-15 to 50 thousand MT 2015-16. This fall in carry-out stocks is mainly due to increased exports and decreased production
- **According to the latest Statpub report, France pea export increased by 66%** to 10.0 Thousand MT in January from previous month of 6.01 Thousand MT. However, it is 23% lower than 13,030 MT shipped during the same month last year. This year export of peas from France is expected to increase.
- **According to the latest report, Canadian Lentil production for 2015-16 increases by around 19%** to 2.4 MMT. Last year it was 1.98 MMT. Due to higher production and good demand, exports are forecasted to reach 2.4 MMT from 2.1 MMT. Season ending stock is expected to decrease from 0.36 MMT to 0.10 MMT. Farmer's average bids are likely to increase from \$585 to \$880/910 per tonnes due to higher demand, less availability of good quality crop and weak Canadian dollar.
- **According to the latest report, Canada Chickpea Production for 2015-16 decreases by around 31 percent** to 0.90 MMT. Canada had produced 1.31 MMT last year. Despite lower production, exports are forecasted to reach 0.85 MMT this year from 0.80 MMT last year due to higher demand. However, season ending stock is expected to decrease from 0.125 MMT to 0.075 MMT. Farmers bids are likely to increase from \$515 to \$685-715 per tonne.
- **According to the latest report, Canada Pea Production for 2015-16 decreases by around 16 percent** to 3.2 MMT. Canada had produced 3.8 MMT last year. Due to lower production, exports are forecasted to reach 2.95 MMT this year from 3.04 MMT last year. Farmer's bids are likely to increase from \$260 to \$305-335 per tonne due to good demand.
- **According to the latest ABARES report, Australian Chickpea production forecast 2015-16** is 1013 kilo tonnes which are around 82% greater than 2014-15 estimate which was 555 kilo tonnes. Australian chickpea harvesting starts from mid September and crops start hitting India market from October onwards.
- **According to latest Canadian update**, for 2016-17 sowing area for lentils in Canada is expected to increase up to 1.8Mha. Furthermore, higher yield is also expected which will lead to increase in production by 20% to 2.85 Mt which is up by 0.57Mt in 2015-16.
- **According to latest Canadian update**, exports for chickpeas are expected to increase from 2014-15 because of increase in demand from Pakistan and US. USDA has estimated US chickpea production at 114 kilotonnes, which is about 10% lower than 2014-15. The average prices can also increase due to higher local demand and higher quotes in international market.
