

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- According to the third advance estimate, India Urad production has increased to 1.88 MMT which is around 8% higher than the second advance estimate. Second advance estimate was 1.74 MMT. At present Urad from Burma in Chennai is coming at \$1560 for FAQ and \$1650 for SQ per tonne. Future contract is being made at Rs 11200-11300 per tones for June shipment. Agriwatch expects range bound movement in coming days.
- According to the local trader of Kanpur region of Uttar Pradesh, new moong started hitting in the mandi. Moisture level is high and overall crop quality is good. This moong is smaller crop and arrival may continue till 1 month. At present, prices of moong in Kanpur mandi is hovering around Rs5800-6000 per quintal with arrival of 20-30 bags per day.
- The WPI has rises from 346.6 in March 2016 to 360.4 in April 2016 for pulses. There has been a considerable rise in WPI of Gram (282.4 for March 2016 and 301.8 for April 2016), Tur (274.1 for March 2016 and 383.8 for April 2016), Urad (495.6 for March 2016 and 505.5 for April 2016) and Moong (390.5 for March 2016 and 398.4 for April 2016).
- According to the Third advance estimate, Chana production has been lowered down to 7.48 MMT which is around 7.5 lower than previous estimate. Second production estimate of chana was of 8.09 MMT. Lower production is due to lower rainfall in major producing states.
- In order to keep the prices down and to have regular supply of Tur, Maharashtra government has asked central government to supply 10 Thousand tonnes of Tur Dal from buffer stock. Maharashtra government has also asked traders to keep 25 per cent of imported tur in state warehouse so that the state demand is met first and rest can be sold to other states. Maharashtra monthly tur demand is around 7 Thousand tonnes.
- MMTC invite bids for import 35 Thousand of Canadian Yellow Pea at JNPT port, Mumbai. Shipment period is 15th August, 2016 to 30th September, 2016. Bid will close on 9th June and should valid till 16th June. Bid should be made for minimum quantity of 30 Thousand tonnes.
- MMTC invite bids for import 2.5 Thousand of Red lentils of Canada or Australia at JNPT and Kolkata port each. Shipment period is 15th September, 2016 to 15th October, 2016. Bid will close on May, 27 and should valid till June, 2. Bid should be made for minimum quantity of 2.5 Thousand tones.
- According to IBIS (provisional data), import of pulses in the week (02 May-08 May) was around 72.9 Thousand tonnes at major ports in India, around 15% higher than previous week's (25 Apr-01 May) import of 63.5 Thousand tonnes. Chana, Green Pea, , Kidney Bean, Masoor, Urad Pigeon Pea and Moong were imported lower this week whereas Cow Pea and Yellow Pea and were imported higher as compared to last week.
- According to IBIS, India green pea imports were around 2.51 Thousand MT tones in the week (02 May- 08 May) which is around 3% lower than last week (26 Apr- 01 May).Last week it was 2.60 Thousand MT. Canada exported around 2.18 thousand MT at an average price of \$ 408.42 Cif per tonne and USA exported 0.33 thousand MT at an average price of \$ 454.95 Cif per tonne. At present Green Pea price in Mumbai market is going around Rs 3200-3400 per quintal.
- According to IBIS (provisional data), India moth imports were around 0.35 Thousand MT tonnes in the week (02 May- 08 May) which is around 36% lower than last week (26 Apr- 01 May).Last week it was 0.55 Thousand MT. Moth was generally imported from Afghanistan at JNPT port at an average price of \$765.16 CiF per tonne. At present, moth price in Jaipur market is hovering around Rs 5600-5700 per quintal.
- FSSAI has issued a regulation draft on imported pulses to ensure quality. They have fixed the foreign matter limit at a maximum 3 per cent by weight. Out of 3 percent allowed maximum of 0.5 percent by weight may be inorganic matter and impurities of animal origin.

Pulses International Fundamental:

- **As per latest update, farmers in Canada are planning to shift their crop from wheat to peas and lentil** due to higher prices and demand in India. Farmers aim to plant 5 million acres of lentils and 4.6 million acres of peas, which will lead to a fall in wheat area to 23.2 million acres.
- **According to latest report by USDA, farmers in the US expect to plant Chickpeas in larger area** as compared to last year due to strong prices and demand. The area for small chickpeas is expected increase by 15% to 83000 acres and area for large chickpeas is expected to increase by 20% to 163000 acres in 2016.
- **According to latest update**, carry-out stocks for Canadian Chickpeas are expected to fall from 125 thousand MT in 2014-15 to 50 thousand MT 2015-16. This fall in carry-out stocks is mainly due to increased exports and decreased production
- **According to the latest Statpub report, France pea export increased by 66%** to 10.0 Thousand MT in January from previous month of 6.01 Thousand MT. However, it is 23% lower than 13,030 MT shipped during the same month last year. This year export of peas from France is expected to increase.
- **According to the latest report, Canadian Lentil production for 2015-16 increases by around 19%** to 2.4 MMT. Last year it was 1.98 MMT. Due to higher production and good demand, exports are forecasted to reach 2.4 MMT from 2.1 MMT. Season ending stock is expected to decrease from 0.36 MMT to 0.10 MMT. Farmer's average bids are likely to increase from \$585 to \$880/910 per tonnes due to higher demand, less availability of good quality crop and weak Canadian dollar.
- **According to the latest report, Canada Chickpea Production for 2015-16 decreases by around 31 percent** to 0.90 MMT. Canada had produced 1.31 MMT last year. Despite lower production, exports are forecasted to reach 0.85 MMT this year from 0.80 MMT last year due to higher demand. However, season ending stock is expected to decrease from 0.125 MMT to 0.075 MMT. Farmers bids are likely to increase from \$515 to \$685-715 per tonne.
- **According to the latest report, Canada Pea Production for 2015-16 decreases by around 16 percent** to 3.2 MMT. Canada had produced 3.8 MMT last year. Due to lower production, exports are forecasted to reach 2.95 MMT this year from 3.04 MMT last year. Farmer's bids are likely to increase from \$260 to \$305-335 per tonne due to good demand.
- **According to the latest ABARES report, Australian Chickpea production forecast 2015-16** is 1013 kilo tonnes which are around 82% greater than 2014-15 estimate which was 555 kilo tonnes. Australian chickpea harvesting starts from mid September and crops start hitting India market from October onwards.
- **According to latest Canadian update**, for 2016-17 sowing area for lentils in Canada is expected to increase up to 1.8Mha. Furthermore, higher yield is also expected which will lead to increase in production by 20% to 2.85 Mt which is up by 0.57Mt in 2015-16.
- **According to latest Canadian update**, exports for chickpeas are expected to increase from 2014-15 because of increase in demand from Pakistan and US. USDA has estimated US chickpea production at 114 kilotonnes, which is about 10% lower than 2014-15. The average prices can also increase due to higher local demand and higher quotes in international market.
