

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- In order to increase domestic production of pulses, Government has increased the MSP of Kharif pulses. Tur MSP increase by 9% to Rs 5,050 per quintal for 2016-17 from Rs 4,625 per quintal last year, Moong support price increase by around 8% to Rs 5,225 per quintal from Rs 4,850 per quintal in the year-ago period, while that of urad increase by 9% to Rs 5,000 per quintal from Rs 4,625 in 2015-16.
- According to IBIS (provisional data), import of pulses in the week (23 May-29 May) was around 65.1 Thousand tonnes at major ports in India, around 31% higher than previous week's (16 May-22 May) import of 49.6 Thousand tonnes. Cow Pea, Masoor, Kidney Bean, Pigeon Pea and Moong were imported lower this week whereas Urad, Chana, Green Pea and Yellow Pea were imported higher as compared to last week.
- According to IBIS, India green pea imports were around 2.28 Thousand MT tones in the week (23 May- 29 May) which is around 57% higher than last week (16 May- 22 May). Last week it was 1.45 Thousand MT. Canada exported around 1.89 thousand MT at an average price of \$ 400.73 Cif per tonne. At present Green Pea price in Mumbai market is going around Rs 3300-3400 per quintal.
- According to IBIS (provisional data), India moth imports were around 0.47 Thousand MT tonnes in the week (23 May- 29 May) which is around 39% lower than last week (16 May- 22 May). Last week it was 0.77 Thousand MT. At present, moth price in Jaipur market is hovering around Rs 5200-5300 per quintal.
- In anticipation to fulfill the shortage of pulses in future, Indian government is in discussion with Myanmar for G- to- G imports for pulses. If materialized, it will help India to have sufficient buffer stock of pulses and in case of unexpected uptrend government would be able to curb it on time. It will also give signal to market participants not to drag market up.
- In order to curb down the rising prices of pulses, central government will provide tur at Rs 66/kg and urad at Rs 82/kg to states. States can sell these pulses in retail market at maximum price of Rs 120/kg. At present imported tur and urad at Mumbai market is hovering around Rs 84-86/kg and Rs 109-111/ kg respectively.
- According to the trade source, area of tur may increase this year as comparison to last year in Maharashtra due to expected favorable condition and higher market prevailing prices. Sowing in Maharashtra will begin in June after initial rain. At present, Tur prices in Hinganghat mandi of Maharashtra is in the range of Rs 8790-8800 per bag with arrival of 2000-2300 bags per day.
- According to local trader of Ahmednagar region of Maharashtra, Chana stock is 75% less than the average years whereas arrival is also lower than the last year. At present chana price in mandi is hovering around Rs 5800-5900 per bag with arrival of 600 bags per day. Agriwatch expects prices of chana to show steady to firm movement in coming days due to good demand from millers/stockiest and lower arrival. However, prices may take some downward movement due to profit booking and demand could lower at higher price.
- There is a burning gossip in the market that area under guar and castor seed is bound to decline this year due to increased possibility of good rainfall in monsoon season and lower prevailing prices of these commodities in cash market. It may shift to pulses and other spices. Around 2 to 4 % area in Maharashtra, Rajasthan and MP under soybean may shift to other lucrative crops as soybean price is ruling 10 % lower in comparison to last year. Guar and castor farmers too would prefer to shift some area to other cash crop due to lower price.
- Central Government suggests the states government not to levy taxes such as mandi tax, Vat etc in order to curb down rising prices of pulses. Beside this, central government also asked governments to establish their own Price Stabilization Fund that can be utilized to check prices of pulses and to fix stock limits for pulse importers, millers and traders.

Pulses International Fundamental:

- **As per latest update, farmers in Canada are planning to shift their crop from wheat to peas and lentil** due to higher prices and demand in India. Farmers aim to plant 5 million acres of lentils and 4.6 million acres of peas, which will lead to a fall in wheat area to 23.2 million acres.
- **According to latest report by USDA, farmers in the US expect to plant Chickpeas in larger area** as compared to last year due to strong prices and demand. The area for small chickpeas is expected increase by 15% to 83000 acres and area for large chickpeas is expected to increase by 20% to 163000 acres in 2016.
- **According to latest update**, carry-out stocks for Canadian Chickpeas are expected to fall from 125 thousand MT in 2014-15 to 50 thousand MT 2015-16. This fall in carry-out stocks is mainly due to increased exports and decreased production
- **According to the latest Statpub report, France pea export increased by 66%** to 10.0 Thousand MT in January from previous month of 6.01 Thousand MT. However, it is 23% lower than 13,030 MT shipped during the same month last year. This year export of peas from France is expected to increase.
- **According to the latest report, Canadian Lentil production for 2015-16 increases by around 19%** to 2.4 MMT. Last year it was 1.98 MMT. Due to higher production and good demand, exports are forecasted to reach 2.4 MMT from 2.1 MMT. Season ending stock is expected to decrease from 0.36 MMT to 0.10 MMT. Farmer's average bids are likely to increase from \$585 to \$880/910 per tonnes due to higher demand, less availability of good quality crop and weak Canadian dollar.
- **According to the latest report, Canada Chickpea Production for 2015-16 decreases by around 31 percent** to 0.90 MMT. Canada had produced 1.31 MMT last year. Despite lower production, exports are forecasted to reach 0.85 MMT this year from 0.80 MMT last year due to higher demand. However, season ending stock is expected to decrease from 0.125 MMT to 0.075 MMT. Farmers bids are likely to increase from \$515 to \$685-715 per tonne.
- **According to the latest report, Canada Pea Production for 2015-16 decreases by around 16 percent** to 3.2 MMT. Canada had produced 3.8 MMT last year. Due to lower production, exports are forecasted to reach 2.95 MMT this year from 3.04 MMT last year. Farmer's bids are likely to increase from \$260 to \$305-335 per tonne due to good demand.
- **According to the latest ABARES report, Australian Chickpea production forecast 2015-16** is 1013 kilo tonnes which are around 82% greater than 2014-15 estimate which was 555 kilo tonnes. Australian chickpea harvesting starts from mid September and crops start hitting India market from October onwards.
- **According to latest Canadian update**, for 2016-17 sowing area for lentils in Canada is expected to increase up to 1.8Mha. Furthermore, higher yield is also expected which will lead to increase in production by 20% to 2.85 Mt which is up by 0.57Mt in 2015-16.
- **According to latest Canadian update**, exports for chickpeas are expected to increase from 2014-15 because of increase in demand from Pakistan and US. USDA has estimated US chickpea production at 114 kilotonnes, which is about 10% lower than 2014-15. The average prices can also increase due to higher local demand and higher quotes in international market.
