

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- According to trade source, tur area in Latur region of Maharashtra may increase around 15-20 percent as compared to last year. Sugarcane area may shift to tur as well as soybean due to high prevailing market price and expectation of good monsoon. Stockiest /traders are believed to have much stock of tur and are engaged in demand based buying due to higher market prices and government pressure. At present, tur prices in Latur mandi is hovering around Rs 9000-9400 per quintal with arrival of 1000-1500 bags per day. AW expects prices to show steady to slightly weak movement due to lower demand and higher crop area coverage in coming season.
- MMTC invites tender to import 5000 MT of Chickpeas (new crop) from Canada or Australia. Shipment date is from 01st August to 15th September, 2016 and should deliver 2500 MT each at Nhava Sheav/JNPT and Chennai port. Minimum bid is of 2500 MT and last date of submission of tender is 15th June 2016 and bid should valid till 22nd June, 2016.
- Chana futures moved with line as expected by Agriwatch last week. Within a time span of a week chana price surged by 15% from Rs 6100 to Rs 7000 per quintal on continuous demand from milling industries/stockiest, despite slightly higher production this year. The main reason behind firmness in chana market is said to be good demand and almost vacant pipeline. Higher demand for Australian chana has lent support to chana market fundamental too. AW expects chana prices to show steady to firm momentum due to good demand. However, downward correction is expected in future market due to profit booking. Overall tone stands bullish.
- According to the local trader of Ludhiana region of Punjab, new moong start hitting the market in good amount. Moisture level is higher around 15-26% but grain quality is good. This year production is expected to be higher than last year due to higher coverage area arrival may continue till August. At present, prices of moong in Ludhiana mandi is hovering around Rs 5800-5900 per quintal with arrival of 20000-22000 bags per day. Agriwatch expects moong prices to show steady to slightly weak movement due to higher availability and higher coverage area expectation in coming Kharif season due to favorable weather condition.
- According to IBIS (provisional data), import of pulses in the week (30 May-05 June) was around 101.1 Thousand tonnes at major ports in India, around 55% higher than previous week's (23 May-29 May) import of 65.1 Thousand tonnes. Chana, Cow Pea, Urad, Pigeon Pea and Moong were imported lower this week whereas Kidney Bean, Masoor, Green Pea and Yellow Pea were imported higher as compared to last week.
- According to IBIS, India green pea imports were around 3.52 Thousand MT tones in the week (30 May-05 June) which is around 54% higher than last week (23 May- 29 May). Last week it was 2.28 Thousand MT. Canada exported around 1.71 thousand MT at an average price of \$ 399.16 Cif per tonne. At present Green Pea price in Mumbai market is going around Rs 3100-3200 per quintal.
- According to IBIS (provisional data), India moth imports were around 0.46 Thousand MT tonnes in the week (30 May-05 June) which is around 1% lower than last week (23 May- 29 May). Last week it was 0.47 Thousand MT. At present, moth price in Jaipur market is hovering around Rs 5500-5600 per quintal.
- In order to increase domestic production of pulses, Government has increased the MSP of Kharif pulses. Tur MSP increase by 9% to Rs 5,050 per quintal for 2016-17 from Rs 4,625 per quintal last year, Moong support price increase by around 8% to Rs 5,225 per quintal from Rs 4,850 per quintal in the year-ago period, while that of urad increase by 9% to Rs 5,000 per quintal from Rs 4,625 in 2015-16.
- In anticipation to fulfill the shortage of pulses in future, Indian government is in discussion with Myanmar for G- to- G imports for pulses. If materialized, it will help India to have sufficient buffer stock of pulses and in case of unexpected uptrend government would able to curb it on time. It will also give signal to market participants not to drag market up.
- In order to curb down the rising prices of pulses, central government will provide tur at Rs 66/kg and urad at Rs 82/kg to states. States can sell these pulses in retail market at maximum price of Rs 120/kg. At present imported tur and urad at Mumbai market is hovering around Rs 84-86/kg and Rs 109-111/ kg respectively.

Pulses International Fundamental:

- **According to the latest Statpub report, France pea export increased** by 210% to 42.16 Thousand MT in month of April from previous month of 13.60 Thousand MT and it is around 106% higher than 20.51 Thousand MT shipped during the same month last year. Total shipments clearance for ten months this year (July to April) is around 27.74 Lakh MT which is 105% higher than 12.06 Lakh MT shipped during the same month last year. Good demand from India and lower stock in domestic market due to lower production this year would continue to lend support to cash market in France and quotes are expected to remain stable to firm in the near term.
- **According to the latest report, Canadian Lentil production estimate for 2016-17** is expected to increase by around 39% to 3.25 MMT. Last year (2015-16) estimate is 2.34 MMT. Due to higher production, exports are forecasted to reach 2.4 MMT in 2016-17 from 2.35 MMT in 2015-16. Season ending stock is expected to increase from 0.03 MMT to 0.60 MMT. Farmer's average bids are likely to decrease from \$1030/1060 to \$765/795 per tones in 2016-17 due to a more normal grade distribution and record Canadian supply.
- **According to the latest report, Canada Pea Production estimate for 2016-17** is expected to increase by around 28 percent to 4.1 MMT. Canada is expected to produce 3.2 MMT in 2015-16. Due to higher production, exports are forecasted to reach 4.23 MMT in 2016-17 from 3.90 MMT in 2015-16. Farmers' bids are likely to decrease from \$360/390 to \$300-330 per tonne due to expectation of larger stock in Canada and increased world supply.
- **As per latest update, farmers in Canada are planning to shift their crop from wheat to peas and lentil** due to higher prices and demand in India. Farmers aim to plant 5 million acres of lentils and 4.6 million acres of peas, which will lead to a fall in wheat area to 23.2 million acres.
- **According to the latest ABARES report, Australian Chickpea production forecast 2015-16** is 1013 kilo tonnes which are around 82% greater than 2014-15 estimate which was 555 kilo tonnes. Australian chickpea harvesting starts from mid September and crops start hitting India market from October onwards.
