

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- According to the latest report of Andhra Pradesh agriculture department, pulses Kharif sowing is at 0.09 Lakh Ha which is around 200% higher than last year as on date(15 June 2016) .Last year it was 0.03 at the same period. Sowing area of urad and moong has sown considerable increase in area due to higher prevailing market price and favorable weather condition.
- According to the local trader of Dabra region of Madhya Pradesh, new moong start hitting the market in good amount. Moisture level is higher around 15-16% but grain quality is good. This small crop of moong may continue till mid July. At present, prices of moong in Dabra mandi is hovering around Rs5600-5800 per quintal with arrival of 500-700 bags per day. Agriwatch expects moong prices to show steady to slightly weak movement due to higher availability and lower demand.
- According to the trade sources, Australian Desi Chickpea forward months contracts are being struck at \$810 for Oct- Nov delivery, \$805 for Nov-Dec delivery and \$800 for Dec-Jan delivery CnF at Mundra/Nhava Sheva Port respectively. At present, Australian Chickpea crop is in good condition and Agriwatch expects higher production this year as compare to last year.
- In order to ensure regular supply and to curb rising prices of pulses, Government approves to import large amount of pulses. It approves to import 3 Lakh tonnes of green lentil, 2 Lakh tonnes of yellow peas, 1Lakh tonnes of red lentil and 20 thousand tonnes each of Urad and Pigeon peas.
- The WPI for Pulses has risen from 360.4 in April 2016 to 385.8 in May 2016. There has been a considerable rise in WPI of Gram (301.8 for April 2016 and 330.6 for May 2016), Tur (383.8 for April 2016 and 393.4 for May 2016), Urad (505.5 for April 2016 and 562.2 for May 2016), Masur (331.2 for April 2016 and 346.5 for May 2016) and Moong (398.4 for April 2016 and 405.2 for May 2016).
- According to the latest circular released by SEBI, no new contracts in chana future (Chana2MT & CHARJDDDEL) would be allowed till further order. Participant would not be allowed to take any fresh position in running contracts. There will be no new Chana future contract shall be launched till further orders on commodity derivative contracts. However, they will be allowed to square up their position in running contracts. It would impact market fundamentals and restrict uptrend in coming days.
- Government decides to increase the buffer stock of pulses from 1.5 Lakh tonnes to 8 Lakh tonnes to ensure continuous flow and to curb down rising prices. This increase in quantity is expected to help farmers to sell pulses at reasonable rate. At present Central Government is providing un-milled tur and urad from buffer stock to state governments at Rs 66 per kg for retail distribution at not more than Rs 120.
- According to IBIS (provisional data), import of pulses in the week (06 June-12 June) was around 61 Thousand tonnes at major ports in India, around 40% lower than previous week's (30 May-05 June) import of 101.1 Thousand tonnes. Chana, Green Pea, Cow Pea, Kidney Bean, Urad, Pigeon Pea and Moong were imported higher this week whereas Masoor and Yellow Pea were imported lower as compared to last week.
- According to IBIS, India green pea imports were around 5.75 Thousand MT tones in the week (06 June-12 June) which is around 63% higher than last week (30 May-05 June).Last week it was 3.52 Thousand MT. Canada exported around 1.65 thousand MT at an average price of \$ 404.98 Cif per tonne. At present Green Pea price in Mumbai market is going around Rs 3100-3200 per quintal.
- According to IBIS (provisional data), India moth imports were around 0.01 Thousand MT tonnes in the week (06 June-12 June) which is around 80% lower than last week (30 May-05 June).Last week it was 0.46 Thousand MT. At present, moth price in Jaipur market is hovering around Rs 5700-5800 per quintal.

Pulses International Fundamental:

- **According to the apk-inform, Russia pea export** during 11 months of 2015/16 MY (July-May) reached 6.95 Lakh tonnes which is around 89 higher than 2014/15 MY export of 3.68 Lakh tonnes. India imports of pea from Russia also increased to 0.70 Lakh tonnes from 0.65 Lakh tonnes.
- **According to the latest Statpub report, France pea export increased** by 210% to 42.16 Thousand MT in month of April from previous month of 13.60 Thousand MT and it is around 106% higher than 20.51 Thousand MT shipped during the same month last year. Total shipments clearance for ten months this year (July to April) is around 27.74 Lakh MT which is 105% higher than 12.06 Lakh MT shipped during the same month last year. Good demand from India and lower stock in domestic market due to lower production this year would continue to lend support to cash market in France and quotes are expected to remain stable to firm in the near term.
- **According to the latest report, Canadian Lentil production estimate for 2016-17** is expected to increase by around 39% to 3.25 MMT. Last year (2015-16) estimate is 2.34 MMT. Due to higher production, exports are forecasted to reach 2.4 MMT in 2016-17 from 2.35 MMT in 2015-16. Season ending stock is expected to increase from 0.03 MMT to 0.60 MMT. Farmer's average bids are likely to decrease from \$1030/1060 to \$765/795 per tones in 2016-17 due to a more normal grade distribution and record Canadian supply.
- **According to the latest report, Canada Pea Production estimate for 2016-17** is expected to increase by around 28 percent to 4.1 MMT. Canada is expected to produce 3.2 MMT in 2015-16. Due to higher production, exports are forecasted to reach 4.23 MMT in 2016-17 from 3.90 MMT in 2015-16. Farmers' bids are likely to decrease from \$360/390 to \$300-330 per tonne due to expectation of larger stock in Canada and increased world supply.
- **As per latest update, farmers in Canada are planning to shift their crop from wheat to peas and lentil** due to higher prices and demand in India. Farmers aim to plant 5 million acres of lentils and 4.6 million acres of peas, which will lead to a fall in wheat area to 23.2 million acres.
- **According to the latest ABARES report, Australian Chickpea production forecast 2015-16** is 1013 kilo tonnes which are around 82% greater than 2014-15 estimate which was 555 kilo tonnes. Australian chickpea harvesting starts from mid September and crops start hitting India market from October onwards.
