

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- According to the local trader of Patna region of Bihar, Lentil demand is lower than normal and arrivals are also lower as farmers are engaged in sowing Kharif crops. At present, Lentil in Patna mandi is hovering around Rs 6300-6500 per quintal with arrival of 400-500 bags per day. Agriwatch expects prices of lentils to show range bound movement in coming days. However, prices may show some firm movement in first week of July.
- According to the local trader of Latur region of Maharashtra, Tur demand is lower than normal. Arrivals are also lower due to weak demand and stockiest/millers are doing need based buying. At present, tur prices in Latur mandi is hovering around Rs 8900-9000 per quintal with arrival of 1000-1500 bags per day. According to Agriwatch, tur prices are going to move in range bound movement in coming days.
- According to local trader of Solapur region of Maharashtra, Chana stock is 60% less than the average years whereas arrival is also lower than the last year. At present chana price in mandi is hovering around Rs 6800-6900 per bag with arrival of around 700 bags per day. Agriwatch expects prices of chana to show steady to slightly firm movement in coming days due to good demand from millers/stockiest and lower arrival.
- In order to curb down prices and to maintain regular supply of pulses, Haryana government lowers down stock limit of pulses for traders, dealers and millers. Stock limit for wholesalers, distributing agents and selling agents has been reduced to 150 quintals from 250 and for retailers it has been reduced to 15 quintals from 25 quintals. Millers would be able to keep only 1/24th of total annual milling done for raw material and 1/48th of total annual milling done for finished goods.
- According to IBIS (provisional data), import of pulses in the week (13 June-19 June) was around 105 Thousand tonnes at major ports in India, around 72% higher than previous week's (06 June-12 June) import of 61 Thousand tonnes. Chickpea, Kidney Bean, Black Matpe, Lentil, Pigeon Pea and Yellow Pea were imported higher this week whereas Green Pea, Cow Pea, and Green Gram were imported lower as compared to last week.
- According to IBIS (provisional data), India moth imports were around 0.12 Thousand MT tonnes in the week (13 June-19 June) which is around 29% higher than last week (06 June-12 June). Last week it was 0.01 Thousand MT. At present, moth price in Jaipur market is hovering around Rs 5500-5600 per quintal.
- According to IBIS, India green pea imports were around 5.08 Thousand MT tonnes in the week (13 June-19 June) which is around 12% lower than last week (06 June-12 June). Last week it was 5.75 Thousand MT. Canada exported around 2.81 thousand MT at an average price of \$ 402.06 Cif per tonne. At present Green Pea price in Mumbai market is going around Rs 3100-3200 per quintal.
- According to the latest report of Andhra Pradesh agriculture department, pulses Kharif sowing is at 0.09 Lakh Ha which is around 200% higher than last year as on date(15 June 2016) .Last year it was 0.03 at the same period. Sowing area of urad and moong has sown considerable increase in area due to higher prevailing market price and favorable weather condition.
- According to the local trader of Dabra region of Madhya Pradesh, new moong start hitting the market in good amount. Moisture level is higher around 15-16% but grain quality is good. This small crop of moong may continue till mid July. At present, prices of moong in Dabra mandi is hovering around Rs5600-5800 per quintal with arrival of 500-700 bags per day. Agriwatch expects moong prices to show steady to slightly weak movement due to higher availability and lower demand.
- The WPI for Pulses has risen from 360.4 in April 2016 to 385.8 in May 2016. There has been a considerable rise in WPI of Gram (301.8 for April 2016 and 330.6 for May 2016), Tur (383.8 for April 2016 and 393.4 for May 2016), Urad (505.5 for April 2016 and 562.2 for May 2016), Masur (331.2 for April 2016 and 346.5 for May 2016) and Moong (398.4 for April 2016 and 405.2 for May 2016).

Pulses International Fundamental:

- **According to the latest Saskatchewan Agriculture's weekly Crop Report**, pulses crop are developing faster than normal this year, with 20% of the crop ahead of normal and 76% at a normal state of development for the third week of June. The majority of the crops are in good-to-excellent condition though excess moisture is causing concerns in some areas. Harvesting of pulses generally begins in August and if the weather continues to be favorable hope for higher production of pulses increases this year.
- **According to the apk-inform, Russia pea export** during 11 months of 2015/16 MY (July-May) reached 6.95 Lakh tonnes which is around 89 higher than 2014/15 MY export of 3.68 Lakh tonnes. India imports of pea from Russia also increased to 0.70 Lakh tonnes from 0.65 Lakh tonnes.
- **According to the latest Statpub report, France pea export increased** by 210% to 42.16 Thousand MT in month of April from previous month of 13.60 Thousand MT and it is around 106% higher than 20.51 Thousand MT shipped during the same month last year. Total shipments clearance for ten months this year (July to April) is around 27.74 Lakh MT which is 105% higher than 12.06 Lakh MT shipped during the same month last year. Good demand from India and lower stock in domestic market due to lower production this year would continue to lend support to cash market in France and quotes are expected to remain stable to firm in the near term.
- **According to the latest report, Canadian Lentil production estimate for 2016-17** is expected to increase by around 39% to 3.25 MMT. Last year (2015-16) estimate is 2.34 MMT. Due to higher production, exports are forecasted to reach 2.4 MMT in 2016-17 from 2.35 MMT in 2015-16. Season ending stock is expected to increase from 0.03 MMT to 0.60 MMT. Farmer's average bids are likely to decrease from \$1030/1060 to \$765/795 per tones in 2016-17 due to a more normal grade distribution and record Canadian supply.
- **According to the latest report, Canada Pea Production estimate for 2016-17** is expected to increase by around 28 percent to 4.1 MMT. Canada is expected to produce 3.2 MMT in 2015-16. Due to higher production, exports are forecasted to reach 4.23 MMT in 2016-17 from 3.90 MMT in 2015-16. Farmers' bids are likely to decrease from \$360/390 to \$300-330 per tonne due to expectation of larger stock in Canada and increased world supply.
- **According to the latest ABARES report, Australian Chickpea production forecast 2015-16** is 1013 kilo tonnes which are around 82% greater than 2014-15 estimate which was 555 kilo tonnes. Australian chickpea harvesting starts from mid September and crops start hitting India market from October onwards.
