

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- According to latest sowing report released by Government as on 15th July 2016, Tur area is recorded at 29.19 Lakh Hectares which is around 57% higher than at the same time period last year. Last year it was 18.62 Lakh hectares. Maharashtra, Karnataka and Madhya Pradesh Tur sowing area was recorded at 10.25, 7.48 and 4.44 respectively.
- According to latest sowing report released by Government as on 15th July 2016, Urad area is recorded at 17.16 Lakh Hectares which is around 55% higher than at the same time period last year. Last year it was 11.05 Lakh hectares. Madhya Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh and Maharashtra Urad sowing area was recorded at 5.87, 2.69 and 3.12 respectively. However some crop loss was reported in some parts of Madhya Pradesh and Maharashtra due to excessive rain.
- According to latest sowing report released by Government as on 15th July 2016, Moong area is recorded at 18.61 Lakh Hectares which is around 27% higher than at the same time period last year. Last year it was 14.71 Lakh hectares. Rajasthan and Maharashtra Moong sowing area were recorded at 8.46 and 3.57 respectively. This year moong sowing in Karnataka also shows considerable increase in area from 2.55 Lakh hectares (last year) to 3.25 Lakh Hectares (current year).
- **Pulses: At JNPT (Mumbai) Port Container Report on July 15:** 93 Container of Pigeon Pea, 22 Container of Green Mung, 22 Container of Chickpeas, 30 Container of Yellow Pea, 16 Container of Green Peas, 33 Container of Black Kidney Bean.
- Chana cash market has shown some downward correction in last few days due to higher availability as stockiest are releasing their stock in fear of government stickiness. Demands from millers are also lowered down as they are expecting more price correction in near term. According to Agriwatch, Chana cash market prices to show some downward correction but inner tone will remain bullish. Chana cash market is showing good support at Rs 8000/quintal, Agriwatch expects prices to show range bound to slightly weak movement in coming days but new buying opportunity will come after downward correction.
- As expected by Agriwatch, Tur prices have shown weak movement in the last week due to lower demand. Millers are only doing need based buying and stockiest are also sidelined as they are expecting more downward movement due to higher sowing data from the government. Agriwatch expects Tur prices to show steady to weak movement in coming days also due to higher imports and lower demand.
- The WPI for Pulses has risen from 385.8 in May 2016 to 400.20 in June 2016. There has been a rise in WPI of Gram (330.6 for May 2016 and 353.0 for June 2016), Tur (393.4 for May 2016 and 394.90 for June 2016) and Urad (562.2 for May 2016 and 604.5 for June 2016) but Masur (346.5 for May 2016 and 343.80 for June 2016) and Moong (405.2 for May 2016 and 387.20 for June 2016) recorded decline in WPI.
- According to IBIS (provisional data), import of pulses in the week (04 July-10 July) was around 65.8 Thousand tonnes at major ports in India, around 6% higher than previous week's (27 June-03 July) import of 62.3 Thousand tonnes. Green Pea and Yellow Pea were imported higher this week whereas Chickpea, Cow Pea, Black Matpe, Pigeon Pea Kidney Bean, Lentil and Green Gram were imported lower as compared to last week.
- According to IBIS (provisional data), India moth imports were around 0.05 Thousand MT tonnes in the week (04 July-10 July) which is same as last week (27 June-03 July). Last week it was 0.05 Thousand MT. At present, moth price in Jaipur market is hovering around Rs 5600-5700 per quintal. Agriwatch expects moth prices to show range bound movement in coming days.
- According to IBIS, India green pea imports were around 9.00 Thousand MT tonnes in the week (04 July-10 July) which is around 169% higher than last week (27 June-03 July). Last week it was 3.35 Thousand MT. Canada exported around 6 thousand MT at an average price of \$ 409.40 Cif per tonne. At present Green Pea price in Mumbai market is going around Rs 3100-3200 per quintal.

Pulses International Fundamental:

- **According to the latest report, Canadian Lentil production estimate** for 2016-17 is expected to increase by around 37% to 3.25 MMT. Last year (2015-16) estimate is 2.37 MMT. Due to higher production, exports are forecasted to reach 2.4 MMT in 2016-17 from 2.30 MMT in 2015-16. Season ending stock is expected to increase from 0.07 MMT to 0.65 MMT. Farmer's average bids are likely to decrease from \$985/1015 to \$765/795 per tonnes in 2016-17 due to a more normal grade distribution and record Canadian supply. Farmer's average bid fall near \$45/tonne in June as compare to May report due to higher production estimate.
- **According to the latest report, Canada Pea Production estimate** for 2016-17 is expected to increase by around 28 percent to 4.1 MMT. Canada is expected to produce 3.2 MMT in 2015-16. Due to higher production, exports are forecasted to reach 4.23 MMT in 2016-17 from 3.90 MMT in 2015-16. Farmers' bids are likely to decrease from \$360/390 to \$300-330 per tonne due to expectation of larger stock in Canada and increased world supply.
- **According to the latest ABARES report, Australian Chickpea production forecast** 2016-17 is 1090 kilo tonnes which are around 8% greater than 2015-16 production estimate of 1013 kilo tonnes. Australia chickpea production forecast is higher due to increase in area and favorable weather condition till now. Australian chickpea harvesting starts from mid September and crops start hitting India market from October onwards.
- **According to the latest Saskatchewan Agriculture's weekly Crop Report**, pulses crop are developing faster than normal this year, with 20% of the crop ahead of normal and 76% at a normal state of development for the third week of June. The majority of the crops are in good-to-excellent condition though excess moisture is causing concerns in some areas. Harvesting of pulses generally begins in August and if the weather continues to be favorable hope for higher production of pulses increases this year.
- **According to the apk-inform, Russia pea export** during 11 months of 2015/16 MY (July-May) reached 6.95 Lakh tonnes which is around 89 higher than 2014/15 MY export of 3.68 Lakh tonnes. India imports of pea from Russia also increased to 0.70 Lakh tonnes from 0.65 Lakh tonnes.
- **According to the latest Statpub report, France pea export increased** by 210% to 42.16 Thousand MT in month of April from previous month of 13.60 Thousand MT and it is around 106% higher than 20.51 Thousand MT shipped during the same month last year. Total shipments clearance for ten months this year (July to April) is around 27.74 Lakh MT which is 105% higher than 12.06 Lakh MT shipped during the same month last year. Good demand from India and lower stock in domestic market due to lower production this year would continue to lend support to cash market in France and quotes are expected to remain stable to firm in the near term.
