

#### **Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:**

- Pulses: At JNPT (Mumbai) Port Container Report on July 26: 65 Container of Pigeon Pea, 59 Container of Mung, 15 Container of Chickpeas, 03 Container of Lentils, 02 Container of Green Peas, 02 Container of Red/Black Kidney Bean and 43 container of Brown/Black Eye Bean.
- According to IBIS (provisional data), import of pulses in the week (18 July-24 July) was around 101.6
  Thousand tonnes at major ports in India, around 37% higher than previous week's (11 July-17 July) import of
  74.2 Thousand tonnes. Chickpea, Lentil, Black Matpe, Cow Pea, Kidney Bean, and Yellow Pea were
  imported higher this week whereas Green Gram, Pigeon Pea and Green Pea were imported lower as
  compared to last week.
- According to IBIS, India green pea imports were around 7.71 Thousand MT tonnes in the week (18 July-24 July) which is around 11% lower than last week (11 July-17 July). Last week it was 8.69 Thousand MT.
   Canada exported around 3.91 thousand MT at an average price of \$ 410.07 Cif per tonne. At present Green Pea price in Mumbai market is going around Rs 3100-3200 per quintal.
- In order to enhance the supply in the mandi and to curb down the prices, Central government asked States
  to remove local taxes on Pulses. They also have been requested to consider a pricing policy to set the
  highest selling price for pulses. This decision will help farmers to get better price for their product and regular
  supply for the consumer at lower rates.
- Agriwatch expects moong cash market to show steady to slightly weak movement due to lower demand and higher availability. Regular imports and higher sowing data released by government will not let moong prices to move northwards. According to latest Kharif sowing report released by Government as on 22nd July 2016, Moong area is recorded at 23.10 Lakh Hectares which is around 44% higher than at the same time period last year. Last year it was 16.06 Lakh hectares.
- As expected by Agriwatch Peas cash market has shown down movement last week. Agriwatch expects Peas
  prices to show weak movement due to lower future Peas contract has been offered by Canadian importers
  as they are expecting higher production this year. Demand also have fallen down as Millers are only doing
  need based buying and stockiest are also sidelined.
- According to latest sowing report released by Government as on 22nd July 2016, Tur sowing area is recorded at 35.90 Lakh Hectares which is around 53% higher than at the same time period last year. Last year it was 23.44 Lakh hectares. Maharashtra, Karnataka and Madhya Pradesh Tur sowing area was recorded at 12.66, 9.07 and 4.71 Lakh Hectares respectively.
- According to latest sowing report released by Government as on 22nd July 2016, Urad sowing area is recorded at 21.76 Lakh Hectares which is around 31% higher than at the same time period last year. Last year it was 16.64 Lakh hectares. Madhya Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh and Maharashtra Urad sowing area was recorded at 7.57, 3.75 and 3.81 Lakh Hectares respectively.
- MMTC invites tender to import 20,000 MT of Chickpeas (new crop) from Canada or Australia. Shipment
  period is from 15th October to 15th November, 2016 and should deliver 10000 MT each at Nhava
  Sheav/JNPT and Kandla port. Minimum bid is of 10000 MT and last date of submission of tender is 08th
  August 2016 and bid should valid till 16th August, 2016.



### **Pulses International Fundamental:**

- According to the latest Saskatchewan Agriculture's weekly Crop Report, 66% of pulses crop are at their
  normal developmental stages, 26 % is ahead of normal development and 8 % is behind normal development for
  this time of year. Lentils and pea crop in many parts are suffering from too much moisture and some crop
  damage is also recorded.
- According to the latest report, Canadian Lentil production estimate for 2016-17 is expected to increase by around 37% to 3.25 MMT. Last year (2015-16) estimate is 2.37 MMT. Due to higher production, exports are forecasted to reach 2.4 MMT in 2016-17 from 2.30 MMT in 2015-16. Season ending stock is expected to increase from 0.07 MMT to 0.65 MMT. Farmer's average bids are likely to decrease from \$985/1015 to \$765/795 per tones in 2016-17 due to a more normal grade distribution and record Canadian supply. Farmer's average bid fall near \$45/tonne in June as compare to May report due to higher production estimate.
- According to the latest report, Canada Pea Production estimate for 2016-17 is expected to increase by around 28 percent to 4.1 MMT. Canada is expected to produce 3.2 MMT in 2015-16. Due to higher production, exports are forecasted to reach 4.23 MMT in 2016-17 from 3.90 MMT in 2015-16. Farmers' bids are likely to decrease from \$360/390 to \$300-330 per tonne due to expectation of larger stock in Canada and increased world supply.
- According to the latest ABARES report, Australian Chickpea production forecast 2016-17 is 1090 kilo
  tonnes which are around 8% greater than 2015-16 production estimate of 1013 kilo tonnes. Australia chickpea
  production forecast is higher due to increase in area and favorable weather condition till now. Australian
  chickpea harvesting starts from mid September and crops start hitting India market from October onwards.
- According to the apk-inform, Russia pea export during 11 months of 2015/16 MY (July-May) reached 6.95
  Lakh tonnes which is around 89 higher than 2014/15 MY export of 3.68 Lakh tonnes. India imports of pea from
  Russia also increased to 0.70 Lakh tonnes from 0.65 Lakh tonnes.
- According to the latest Statpub report, France pea export increased by 210% to 42.16 Thousand MT in month of April from previous month of 13.60 Thousand MT and it is around 106% higher than 20.51 Thousand MT shipped during the same month last year. Total shipments clearance for ten months this year (July to April) is around 27.74 Lakh MT which is 105% higher than 12.06 Lakh MT shipped during the same month last year. Good demand from India and lower stock in domestic market due to lower production this year would continue to lend support to cash market in France and quotes are expected to remain stable to firm in the near term.
