

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- **Pulses: At JNPT (Mumbai) Port Container Report on August 03:** 01 Container of Black Matpe, 10 Container of Moong, 39 Container of Chickpeas, 25 Container of Lentils, 25 Container of Yellow Peas and 12 Container of Green Peas.
- **Pulses: At JNPT (Mumbai) Port Container Report on August 02:** 42 Container of Pigeon Pea, 20 Container of Black Matpe, 64 Container of Moong, 90 Container of Chickpeas, 19 Container of Lentils, 25 Container of Yellow Peas, 89 Container of Green Peas, 32 Container of Red/Black kidney Bean and 01 Container of Brown/Black Eye Bean.
- According to IBIS (provisional data), import of pulses in the week (25 July-31 July) was around 74.8 Thousand tonnes at major ports in India, around 26% lower than previous week's (18 July-24 July) import of 101.6 Thousand tonnes. Chickpea, Green Pea, Cow Pea and Pigeon Pea were imported higher this week whereas Green Gram, Lentil, Black Matpe, Kidney Bean, and Yellow Pea were imported lower as compared to last week.
- According to IBIS, India green pea imports were around 8.40 Thousand MT tonnes in the week (25 July-31 July) which is around 9% higher than last week (18 July-24 July). Last week it was 7.71 Thousand MT. Canada exported around 5.32 thousand MT at an average price of \$ 417.23 Cif per tonne. At present Green Pea price in Mumbai market is going around Rs 2800-2900 per quintal.
- As expected by Agriwatch, Chana cash market showed weak movement last week due to lower demand. According to the trade source, at present Chana Future Contract are struck at \$805 for October-November, \$800 for November-December and \$790 for December-January delivery respectively. Stockiest are releasing their stock for profit booking, keeping downward pressure on the market. Agriwatch expects Chana prices to show slightly weak movement in the coming days due to higher availability. However, prices may show firmness if availability decrease as stockiest may not release their stock at lower prices.
- According to latest sowing report released by Government as on 29th July 2016, Urad sowing area is recorded at 26.77 Lakh Hectares which is around 35% higher than at the same time period last year. Last year it was 19.78 Lakh hectares. Agriwatch expects Urad prices to show range bound to slightly weak movement due to higher imports from Myanmar and higher sowing data released by government. Millers are also doing need based buying at current price and stockiest are releasing their stock.
- According to latest sowing report released by Government as on 29th July 2016, Tur sowing area is recorded at 42.93 Lakh Hectares which is around 68% higher than at the same time period last year. Last year it was 25.61 Lakh hectares. As expected by Agriwatch, Tur prices have shown weak movement in the last week due to higher imports and lower demand. At present, Stockiest are sidelined and millers are doing need based buying keeping prices down. Agriwatch expects Tur prices to show range bound to slightly weak movement in coming days due to higher imports.
- According to latest Kharif sowing report released by Government as on 29th July 2016, Moong area is recorded at 26.14 Lakh Hectares which is around 38% higher than at the same time period last year. Last year it was 18.88 Lakh hectares. Rajasthan and Maharashtra Moong sowing area were recorded at 11.97 and 4.70 respectively. This year moong sowing in Karnataka also shows considerable increase in area from 2.76 Lakh hectares (last year) to 3.74 Lakh Hectares (current year).
- As per latest NCDEX circular, all Chana Contracts has been closed from immediate effect. The sellers who have stocks and intending to give delivery will be allowed to do so. The delivery settlement will be communicated to the members after revision. The remaining outstanding positions after 27th July, 2016 will be closed out at the volume weighted average of futures price of August 2016 Chana Contract traded on 27th July, 2016 which was Rs 8055/quintal.

Pulses International Fundamental:

- **According to the latest Saskatchewan Agriculture's weekly Crop Report**, 66% of pulses crop are at their normal developmental stages, 26 % is ahead of normal development and 8 % is behind normal development for this time of year. Lentils and pea crop in many parts are suffering from too much moisture and some crop damage is also recorded.
- **According to the latest report, Canadian Lentil production estimate** for 2016-17 is expected to increase by around 37% to 3.25 MMT. Last year (2015-16) estimate is 2.37 MMT. Due to higher production, exports are forecasted to reach 2.4 MMT in 2016-17 from 2.30 MMT in 2015-16. Season ending stock is expected to increase from 0.07 MMT to 0.65 MMT. Farmer's average bids are likely to decrease from \$985/1015 to \$765/795 per tonnes in 2016-17 due to a more normal grade distribution and record Canadian supply. Farmer's average bid fall near \$45/tonne in June as compare to May report due to higher production estimate.
- **According to the latest report, Canada Pea Production estimate** for 2016-17 is expected to increase by around 28 percent to 4.1 MMT. Canada is expected to produce 3.2 MMT in 2015-16. Due to higher production, exports are forecasted to reach 4.23 MMT in 2016-17 from 3.90 MMT in 2015-16. Farmers' bids are likely to decrease from \$360/390 to \$300-330 per tonne due to expectation of larger stock in Canada and increased world supply.
- **According to the latest ABARES report, Australian Chickpea production forecast** 2016-17 is 1090 kilo tonnes which are around 8% greater than 2015-16 production estimate of 1013 kilo tonnes. Australia chickpea production forecast is higher due to increase in area and favorable weather condition till now. Australian chickpea harvesting starts from mid September and crops start hitting India market from October onwards.
- **According to the apk-inform, Russia pea export** during 11 months of 2015/16 MY (July-May) reached 6.95 Lakh tonnes which is around 89 higher than 2014/15 MY export of 3.68 Lakh tonnes. India imports of pea from Russia also increased to 0.70 Lakh tonnes from 0.65 Lakh tonnes.
- **According to the latest Statpub report, France pea export increased** by 210% to 42.16 Thousand MT in month of April from previous month of 13.60 Thousand MT and it is around 106% higher than 20.51 Thousand MT shipped during the same month last year. Total shipments clearance for ten months this year (July to April) is around 27.74 Lakh MT which is 105% higher than 12.06 Lakh MT shipped during the same month last year. Good demand from India and lower stock in domestic market due to lower production this year would continue to lend support to cash market in France and quotes are expected to remain stable to firm in the near term.
