

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- According to latest sowing report released by Government as on 19th August, 2016, Pulses Kharif sowing reached to 136.04 Lakh hectares which is around 35% higher than at the corresponding time period last year. Last year it was 100.57 Lakh hectares.
- As expected by Agriwatch, Chana Cash market showed range bound movement last week as stockiest are not releasing their stock at lower prices. Chana forward contracts of future months are struck at lower prices but lower imports at present are not letting prices to move downwards. Agriwatch expects Chana cash market to show range bound to slightly weak movement as demand is below normal.
- According to latest sowing report released by Government as on 19th August 2016, Moong sowing area is recorded at 31.38 Lakh Hectares which is around 37% higher than at the corresponding period last year. Last year it was 22.83 Lakh hectares. Agriwatch expects Moong prices to show range bound to slightly weak movement due to arrival of new moong in Karnataka and Maharashtra. Quality of new moong is normal and arrivals may not let the cash prices to move upwards.
- According to latest sowing report released by Government as on 19th August 2016, Tur sowing area is recorded at 49.89 Lakh Hectares which is around 49% higher than at the same time period last year. Last year it was 33.49 Lakh hectares. Prices of Tur have shown downward movement in the market due to regular imports and expectation of higher production this year. Agriwatch expects Tur prices to show range bound to slightly weak movement in coming days due to lower demand. Stockiest are also releasing their stocks and millers are only doing need based buying.
- According to local trader of Barsi district of Maharashtra, new moong start hitting the market in small quantity. Quality of moong is good and moisture level is around 6-8 %. At present arrival of Moong in Barsi market is around 100-150 bags per day with price range of Rs 4000-5100 per bag.
- **Pulses: At JNPT (Mumbai) Port Container Report on August 09:** 124 Container of Pigeon Pea, 44 Container of Moong, 55 Container of Chickpeas, 38 Container of Lentils, 30 Container of Yellow Peas, 69 Container of Green Peas and 44 Container of Brown/Black Eye Bean.
- According to IBIS (provisional data), import of pulses in the week (01 August-05 August) was around 84.4 Thousand tonnes at major ports in India, around 13% higher than previous week's (25 July-31 July) import of 74.8 Thousand tonnes. Kidney Bean, Lentil, Green Gram and Yellow Pea were imported higher this week whereas Black Matpe, Chickpea, Green Pea, Cow Pea and Pigeon Pea were imported lower as compared to last week.
- According to IBIS, India green pea imports were around 4.95 Thousand MT tonnes in the week (01 August-05 August) which is around 41% lower than last week (25 July-31 July). Last week it was 8.40 Thousand MT. Canada exported around 4.00 thousand MT at an average price of \$ 413.07 Cif per tonne. At present Green Pea price in Mumbai market is going around Rs 2700-2800 per quintal.
- As expected by Agriwatch Peas cash market has shown downward movement last week. According to the trade source, at present Pea Future Contract are struck at \$355 for August-September and \$370 for September-October delivery respectively. Agriwatch expects Peas prices to show range bound to slightly weak movement due to lower demand and higher availability as stockiest are releasing their stock.

Pulses International Fundamental:

- **According to the latest Saskatchewan Agriculture's weekly Crop Report**, 66% of pulses crop are at their normal developmental stages, 26 % is ahead of normal development and 8 % is behind normal development for this time of year. Lentils and pea crop in many parts are suffering from too much moisture and some crop damage is also recorded.
- **According to the latest report, Canadian Lentil production estimate** for 2016-17 is expected to increase by around 37% to 3.25 MMT. Last year (2015-16) estimate is 2.37 MMT. Due to higher production, exports are forecasted to reach 2.4 MMT in 2016-17 from 2.30 MMT in 2015-16. Season ending stock is expected to increase from 0.07 MMT to 0.65 MMT. Farmer's average bids are likely to decrease from \$985/1015 to \$765/795 per tonnes in 2016-17 due to a more normal grade distribution and record Canadian supply. Farmer's average bid fall near \$45/tonne in June as compare to May report due to higher production estimate.
- **According to the latest report, Canada Pea Production estimate** for 2016-17 is expected to increase by around 28 percent to 4.1 MMT. Canada is expected to produce 3.2 MMT in 2015-16. Due to higher production, exports are forecasted to reach 4.23 MMT in 2016-17 from 3.90 MMT in 2015-16. Farmers' bids are likely to decrease from \$360/390 to \$300-330 per tonne due to expectation of larger stock in Canada and increased world supply.
- **According to the latest ABARES report, Australian Chickpea production forecast** 2016-17 is 1090 kilo tonnes which are around 8% greater than 2015-16 production estimate of 1013 kilo tonnes. Australia chickpea production forecast is higher due to increase in area and favorable weather condition till now. Australian chickpea harvesting starts from mid September and crops start hitting India market from October onwards.
- **According to the apk-inform, Russia pea export** during 11 months of 2015/16 MY (July-May) reached 6.95 Lakh tonnes which is around 89 higher than 2014/15 MY export of 3.68 Lakh tonnes. India imports of pea from Russia also increased to 0.70 Lakh tonnes from 0.65 Lakh tonnes.
- **According to the latest Statpub report, France pea export increased** by 210% to 42.16 Thousand MT in month of April from previous month of 13.60 Thousand MT and it is around 106% higher than 20.51 Thousand MT shipped during the same month last year. Total shipments clearance for ten months this year (July to April) is around 27.74 Lakh MT which is 105% higher than 12.06 Lakh MT shipped during the same month last year. Good demand from India and lower stock in domestic market due to lower production this year would continue to lend support to cash market in France and quotes are expected to remain stable to firm in the near term.
