

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- Govt has decided to increase buffer stock limit from 8 lakh tonne to 20 lakh tonne to keep pulses price under control and encourage farmers. The C C E Affairs(Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs) has approved the proposal of Department of Consumer Affairs on enhancing the buffer stock for pulses up to 20 lakh tonnes. Out of 20 lakh tonne,10 lakh tonne would be sourced from domestic market and the rest 10 lakh tonne from import. The latest decision is very crucial as it would help to stabilize price in domestic market and ease tight supply side
- Nafed commences moong procurement in Maharashtra (Amarawati) from yesterday (8th Aug). Local sources confirmed that 15 bags have been procured at MSP of Rs 5225 per qtl. Commencement of procurement is likely to lend support to cash market fundamental. As prices of moong is ruling lower than fixed MSP(Rs(5250 per qtl.),procurement drive is likely to continue. It would help farmers to receive MSP for their newly harvested crop. Moong market may stay steady near MSP level in Maharashtra. How much quantity would be procured is still not clear. Crop size is estimated higher this year.
- Crop condition of moong in Rajasthan is in very good shape and traders expects bumper production this year.If govt. stays away from procurement, moong price may slip drastically-says traders. Arrival of moong may touch 25000 bags par day in Rajasthan. So pressure on price starts reflecting.
- **Pulses: At JNPT (Mumbai) Port Container Report on September 07:** 90 Container of Pigeon Pea, 15 Container of Moong,310 Container of Chickpeas,63 Container of Lentils, 764 Container of Yellow Peas ,113 Container of Green Peas,08 Container of Red/Black Kidney Bean and 06 Container of Brown/Black Eye Bean.
- According to latest sowing report released by Government as on 02nd September, 2016, Kharif sowing of pulses reached 142.02 Lakh hectares which is around 33% higher than at the corresponding time period last year. Last year it was 106.92 Lakh hectares.
- Chana cash market has shown firm movement in couple of days due to possibility of crop loss in Australia due to rain in chickpea growing region. Agriwatch expects prices to show steady to firm movement in coming days due to lower availability of chana in domestic market and higher demand. Australia September shipment is expected to reach in October therefore availability will be lower in coming days.
- The State Trading Corporation of India Limited, New Delhi, has floated an Expression of Interest (EOI) for empanelment of foreign Suppliers of Pulses for supply to STC on long term basis. The EOI document is available on STC's website www.stclimited.co.in. The last date of submission of EOI documents to STC New Delhi is 1500 Hours of 19.09.2016.
- According to IBIS (provisional data), import of pulses in the week (22 August-28 August) was around 74.1 Thousand tonnes at major ports in India, around 39% higher than previous week's (15 August-21 August) import of 53.5 Thousand tonnes. Chickpea, Cow Pea, Lentil, Yellow Pea and Pigeon Pea were imported higher this week whereas Black Matpe, Green Pea, Kidney Bean and Green Gram were imported lower as compared to last week.
- According to the local trader of Jalgaon region of Maharashtra, new urad crop hits mandi in small amount. Crop quality is good and moisture level is between 16-17 %. At present, Urad new crop prices in the mandi is in the range of Rs 5500-6000 per bag with arrival of 100 bags per day. Higher crop arrival is expected in the coming days.
- Indian government has decided to import 90 Thousand tonnes of pulses for buffer stock. It will consist of 40 Thousand tonnes of Masur, 20 Thousand tonnes of Tur, 20 Thousand tonnes of Desi Chana and 10 Thousand tonnes of Urad. This decision might put more pressure on downward moving prices of pulses in India.
- According to the local trader of Gulbarga region of Karnataka, new urad crop start hitting the mandi in small quantity. Crop quality is good and moisture level in between 12-15 %. Urad new crop price range in Gulbarga mandi is between Rs 7000-8000 per quintal with arrival of 70-80 bags per day. Higher arrivals are expected to come after few days.

Pulses International Fundamental:

- **As per latest updates by USA Lentil and dry pea council pulses yields in 2016 are extremely high with excellent quality.** (0% of the crop looks like US# 1 grade. Both lentils green and red were seen with very good color and size. Green peas color is excellent and a good size. This years US crop is one of the best crops both in quality and quantity. Official data is still awaited.
- **Canada, and Stats Canada projects they could have the second largest crop on record** at 33.6 million tons. The most recent crop progress report has the Saskatchewan harvest at approximately 49% for Lentils, 63% for peas and 6% for chickpeas.
- **According to the latest Saskatchewan Agriculture's weekly Crop Report**, 40 % Lentils and 64 % Peas has already been harvested. Harvesting activities is in full swing as rain has stopped. The majority of crop damage last week was due to prolonged flooding and disease. There are some reports of bleaching of pulses in the region.
- **According to the latest report, Canadian Lentil production estimate** for 2016-17 is expected to increase by around 37% to 3.25 MMT. Last year (2015-16) estimate is 2.37 MMT. Due to higher production, exports are forecasted to reach 2.4 MMT in 2016-17 from 2.30 MMT in 2015-16. Season ending stock is expected to increase from 0.07 MMT to 0.65 MMT. Farmer's average bids are likely to decrease from \$985/1015 to \$765/795 per tones in 2016-17 due to a more normal grade distribution and record Canadian supply. Farmer's average bid fall near \$45/tonne in June as compare to May report due to higher production estimate.
- **According to the latest report, Canada Pea Production estimate** for 2016-17 is expected to increase by around 28 percent to 4.1 MMT. Canada is expected to produce 3.2 MMT in 2015-16. Due to higher production, exports are forecasted to reach 4.23 MMT in 2016-17 from 3.90 MMT in 2015-16. Farmers' bids are likely to decrease from \$360/390 to \$300-330 per tonne due to expectation of larger stock in Canada and increased world supply.
- **According to the latest ABARES report, Australian Chickpea production forecast** 2016-17 is 1090 kilo tonnes which are around 8% greater than 2015-16 production estimate of 1013 kilo tonnes. Australia chickpea production forecast is higher due to increase in area and favorable weather condition till now. Australian chickpea harvesting starts from mid September and crops start hitting India market from October onwards.
- **According to the apk-inform, Russia pea export** during 11 months of 2015/16 MY (July-May) reached 6.95 Lakh tonnes which is around 89 higher than 2014/15 MY export of 3.68 Lakh tonnes. India imports of pea from Russia also increased to 0.70 Lakh tonnes from 0.65 Lakh tonnes.
- **According to the latest Statpub report, France pea export increased** by 210% to 42.16 Thousand MT in month of April from previous month of 13.60 Thousand MT and it is around 106% higher than 20.51 Thousand MT shipped during the same month last year. Total shipments clearance for ten months this year (July to April) is around 27.74 Lakh MT which is 105% higher than 12.06 Lakh MT shipped during the same month last year. Good demand from India and lower stock in domestic market due to lower production this year would continue to lend support to cash market in France and quotes are expected to remain stable to firm in the near term.
