

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- **Import of pulses by private and public sector continues and govt . is trying to ensure** ample availability and checking price. Minister of State for Food and Consumer Affairs C R Chaudhary said that country has imported total 27,484,73 T pulses till October, starting from April. In last fiscal India had imported 57.97 lakh tonne. Pulses production had decreased to 165 lakh tonne last year. Shortfall impact was reflected on price . This year situation is likely to improve at production as well as import front. Combined production of Kharif -Rabi is expected to 20 MMT. If India imports over 4 MMT, availability will go up to 24MMT against 22MMT consumption. This shows that pressure on pulses price would continue.
- **Pulses Rabi sowing has crossed 80% of normal area of 140.67lakh ha so far** and is running ahead by 13.13 % to 112.2 lakh ha from last year as on 02.12.2016. Chana, the main Rabi pulses, area coverage has been registered at 76.69 lakh ha, higher by 11.84 percent from last year till date. Its normal area is 88.37 lakh ha. Weather remains favorable and sowing is expected to be over by mid-December. Chana area may exceed normal as prices are ruling still higher. Higher MSP of Rs 4000 per qtl. ,including bonus, too has encouraged farmers to grow more Chana this year.
- **Out of total Rabi coverage under pulses Lentils is running ahead by 32.12 %** from 9.37lakh ha (last year till 2nd Dec-2015) to 12.38 lakh ha, Peas up by 53.03 % from 5.52 to 8.48 lakh ha and Litherus by 12.62 % from 3.01 to 3.39 lakh ha. However, Urad, Moong and Kulthi lags behind by 2.86, 15.38 and 16.96 percent from last year during the same period . These pulses area has been registered at 3.73, 1.54 and 2.79 lakh ha. respectively against 3.84, 1.82 & 3.36 lakh ha. As sowing of Moong would continue in January too, normal area might be covered. Urad may lag behind marginally due to shifting of Urad area to other pulses and spices.
- **Tur lemon in Mumbai is being traded at Rs 5450/5500 per qtl. Steady to** slightly weak tone may prevail in coming days as pressure is building up from import flow.. Urad quote too decreased from Rs 7500 to Rs 7200/7300 per qtl. and may continue to trade down. Chana is being traded at Rs 8800 per qtl. 1st vessel quotes were in the range of Rs 8500 to Rs 8600 per qtl. Tanzania and Ethiopia quotes were seen at Rs 8800 and Rs 8000 per qtl. Downward pressure continues as large volume of import is expected in Dec. Chana price may continue to dip. Matar Canada is being traded at Rs 2311/21 while Masur is being quoted at Rs 4800/4850 per qtl in Mumbai. Overall, sentiment in pulses market remains weak.
- **After 35000 T Australian Chana that landed at Mundra port on 13 Nov, MV HALIL SAHIN** carrying about 42000 T Australian Chana is expected to arrive on 24th Nov-2016. Other shipment from same origin carrying 23700 T Chana is expected to land Mumbai port on 7th December. These arrivals would ease supply side further and pressurize cash Chana market in India.
- **The second major Rabi pulses is Lentils and its planting too is running smooth.** Out of normal area of 14.79 lakh ha. farmers have covered 10.4 lakh ha so far. It is 43.65 percent higher from last year till date (25th Nov). M.P, Uttar Pradesh and Bihar are major producers of Lentils. Despite demonetization, farmers are engaged to finish planting in time as prices rules higher, weather remains favorable and govt would procure Lentils if prices crases below MSP of Rs 3925 per qtl. in the season.
- **Peas planting too have increased considerably this year. Out of 8.37 lakh ha of normal area** farmers have planted 7.92 lakh ha so far, higher by 76.79 from last year till date. Given the pace of ongoing planting peas area may cross from normal this year. The new crop would start hitting the market from Jan end and it would continue to build up pressure on price. Experts say that peas price may dip below Rs 2000 in the season. Currently, pea is being imported in highest volume from Ukraine, Canada and US.
- **Despite better progressive sowing status of Rabi season Urad lags behind** from last year by 9.19 percent to 2.57 lakh ha so far. Its normal Rabi area is 7.54 lakh ha. Farmers had planted 2.83 lakh ha last year till 25th. Nov. The reason behind lower area under Urad is farmer;s preference to other short duration crops in Rabi season. They have preferred to grow more spices and Chana this season. However, total coverage by the end of sowing season may reach near 7 lakh ha.
- **India imported 320012 tonne pulses during 14th to 20th Nov-2016, higher by 12 %** from previous week .It had imported 283426 tonne pulses during week ended 13th Nov-2016. The highest quantity was of yellow peas out of total import during the week. India imported 212588 tonne yellow peas, 32530 tonne Tur , 2708 tonne Urad and 46012 tonne Chana. During this period .Besides, 19834 T Lentils has been imported. The rest were other pulses including kidney beans

Pulses International Fundamental:

- **As per the latest survey data issued(6th Dec) by Statistics Canada hints** record pea and Lentils production in 2016-17. The agency have pegged 4.8 MMT pea production, higher by 1 MMT from record of 2013. Similarly Lentils crop has been pegged at 3.2 MMT against 2.5 MMT produced last year. Traders see these figures as per their previous expectation. Number 2 Laird lentils are currently topping out at about 63 cents per pound in Western Canada, while red lentils are bid up to 32.5 cents per pound. Large calibre (10mm) kabuli chickpeas are currently seeing prices top out at 65 cents per pound.
- **Laird 1 Lentils in Western Canada continued to inched up to 66 cents per pound**, almost 5 cents up from a fortnight ago. Light Kidney beans dropped a little bit and its average bid comes to 43.5 cents per pound. Despite bad weather farmers in Australia expects 2 T per ha yield this year. The main problems for them were ascochyta blight and water-logging issues. Delayed harvesting would delay shipment and New Indian crop would hit the market by end feb. This means they have two and a half months to ship their crop at higher prevailing price. India would not buy Chana from March. It is clear due to bumper production prospect this year. For Australia it would be very difficult to ship maximum marketable surplus in two months. So pressure on global domestic Chick peas market looms large.
- **Australia is exporting lentils to India at \$680/85 per tonne while Canada is offering lentils at \$750 per tonne.** Cheaper supply from Australia has put pressure on Canadian lentils quote. According to the Prairie Ag Hotwire, 1 Red Lentils in Western Canada decreased by one cent per pound last week. Bids ranged from 27 cents per pound at the lows to 34 cents at the highs. green pea is being offered in the range of C\$7.50 to as high as C\$9.00 per bushel in Western Canada. Pressure would continue as supply side has eased and buyers are in bargaining seat now.
- **Despite current uptrend Lentils price in Canada is unlikely to** move north way in coming weeks. Currently it is being traded at 66 cents (CND) per pound. Laird 1 lentils are being quoted in the range of 61 to 66 cents per pound. Kabuli Chana is being traded at 64 to 65 cents per pound. In Indian market there is a pressure on Lentils and Chana markets it may trade lower due to lower demand in local markets. Consumers are turning to green vegetables.
- **Chickpeas import from US In India is increasing fast. India imported 20607 MT Chickpeas** in Sept and Volume is expected to be higher in Oct. Data is awaited. Surprisingly, it is 73 % of total Chickpeas export from US in a month. Turkey and Spain brought the rest volume. The reason behind higher import from US is said to be crop loss around 70 % in Canada due to wet condition.
- **Lentils import volume from US too increased to 19326 T, around 30.9 % of total lentil** export in a month. India imported 74526 tonne dry peas from US too, 75.4 % of total dry peas export in a month. India imported 1.14 lakh tonne pulses from US out of total export of 1.9 lakh tonne. Higher import volume is likely to continue as prices in India still rules higher despite decreased price.
- **Pulses prices in Canada have moved up in recent weeks. Lentils local quotes for** Number 2 Laird varieties are currently hovering in the range of 48 to 61 cents per pound in Western Canada. Green pea prices range from C\$7.50 to as high as C\$9.00 per bushel.
- **Farmers in Australia have been taking advantage of higher chickpea price.** Drought affected crop and tight supply side have temporarily lent support to chickpea price from AU\$800 per tonne to AU\$1,000 per tonne. However, firmness would not sustain in the medium term once Indian crop starts hitting the market in Feb this year.
- **This year production of Lentils in US is up by 136 % to 5.64 lakh tonne** due higher planted area that increased by 90 % to 9.35 lakh acres. Actual harvesting has been reported 9.17 lakh acres. States like Montana, North Dakota, and the United States have recorded record area. Average yield is expected to be 1,356 pounds per acre, up 248 pounds from 2015.
- **According to the latest update by market viewers in Australia, Lentil** crop in some pockets of western Australia has been affected by severe outbreaks of botrytis grey mould. Experts say that South Australia and Victoria alone have planted 2.5 lakh ha Lentil this year and out of this 50 % is said to be affected by this botrytis grey mould. Quality and yield is expected to be affected badly and it would reduce the final size of the crop.
- **As per the latest ABARE update chickpeas production in Australia may increase** to 12.34 lakh tonne in 2016-17. The production estimate for 2015-16 was 10.13 lakh tonne. higher price of chana encouraged farmers to grow more chana and the trend may continue if prices continue to rule at higher level. Area under chickpeas

is forecast to increase from 6.61 to 8.22 lakh ha in 2016-17. Lentil production too may move up from 2.58 to 3.65 lakh tonne for the same period.

- **According to the latest report, Canada Pea Production estimate** for 2016-17 is expected to increase by around 28 percent to 4.1 MMT. Canada is expected to produce 3.2 MMT in 2015-16. Due to higher production, exports are forecasted to reach 4.23 MMT in 2016-17 from 3.90 MMT in 2015-16. Farmers' bids are likely to decrease from \$360/390 to \$300-330 per tonne due to expectation of larger stock in Canada and increased world supply.
